

HOUSE BILL No. 4382

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Hoffman, Martin, Barns,
Walberg and Van Regenmorter and referred to the Committee on Corrections.

A bill to repeal Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1935,
entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of probation recovery
camps; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state prison
commission with respect thereto; to designate persons eligible
for entrance in said camps, and to declare the effect of this
act,"

being sections 798.1 to 798.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1935, being
2 sections 798.1 to 798.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 repealed.

4 Section 2. This act shall not take effect unless Senate
5 Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4378 (request no. 01893'89) of
6 the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
