## **HOUSE BILL No. 4382**

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Hoffman, Martin, Barns, Walberg and Van Regenmorter and referred to the Committee on Corrections.

A bill to repeal Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1935, entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of probation recovery camps; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state prison commission with respect thereto; to designate persons eligible for entrance in said camps, and to declare the effect of this act,"

being sections 798.1 to 798.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
