- 1 (2) -A EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A 2 communication between a certified social worker, social worker, 3 or social work technician, or an agency of which the certified 4 social worker, social worker, or social work technician is an 5 agent and a person counseled is confidential. This privilege is 6 not subject to waiver except when the disclosure is part of the 7 required supervisory process within the agency for which the cer-8 tified social worker, social worker, or social work technician is 9 employed; or except where so waived by the client or a person 10 authorized to act in the client's behalf.
