A bill to amend section 1440 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
being section 600.1440 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 1440 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1961, being section 600.1440 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1440. (1) Whenever any AN oath or affidavit is or
- 5 may be required or authorized by law in any cause, matter, or
- 6 proceeding, except oaths to witnesses and jurors in the trial of
- 7 a cause, and such other oaths as are or may be OTHER THAN AN
- 8 OATH TAKEN BY A WITNESS OR A JUROR IN A TRIAL, OR AN OATH
- 9 required by law to be taken before A particular officers, the

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- 1 same OFFICER, may be taken before any A justice, judge, or
 2 clerk of any A court, or BEFORE A notary public.
- 3 (2) If the person making the oath, affidavit, or an affirma-
- 4 tion is serving in or with the armed forces of the United States,
- 5 or is a civilian employee of the armed forces, or is a dependent
- 6 of a person serving in or with the armed forces or of a civilian
- 7 employee thereof, whether serving in or outside of the territo-
- 8 rial limits of the United States, such oath or affirmation may be
- 9 administered by any commissioned officer in active service of the
- 10 armed forces of the United States.
- 11 (3) The oath or AN instrument sworn to or affirmed
- 12 BEFORE A MILITARY OFFICER PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION is not
- 13 -rendered invalid by the failure to state therein BECAUSE THE
- 14 INSTRUMENT FAILS TO STATE the place wherein WHERE the oath or
- 15 affirmation was taken. An authentication of -the- A MILITARY
- 16 officer's authority to administer the oath or affirmation is not
- 17 required, but the officer administering the -same OATH OR
- 18 AFFIRMATION shall indorse -thereon and attach -thereto- TO THE
- 19 INSTRUMENT a certificate containing , in addition to the requi-
- 20 site or appropriate contents of such certificate, a ALL OF THE
- 21 FOLLOWING:
- 22 (A) A statement -to-the effect that the affiant or affi-
- 23 rmant is known TO BE, or HAS satisfactorily -proven PROVED to
- 24 -such THE officer -to-be serving in or with THAT HE OR SHE IS,
- 25 A MEMBER OF the armed forces of the United States -and OR THE
- 26 DEPENDENT OF A MEMBER, OR A CIVILIAN EMPLOYEE OF THE ARMED FORCES
- 27 OR THE DEPENDENT OF A CIVILIAN EMPLOYEE.

- 1 (B) A STATEMENT that the officer -so-certifying is -at the
- 2 date of his or her certificate a commissioned officer in active
- 3 service of WITH the armed forces. and shall set forth his or
- 4 her-
- 5 (C) A STATEMENT OF THE OFFICER'S rank, and the command to
- 6 which he or she is attached. -and any
- 7 (4) AN instrument -so- sworn -to- or affirmed BEFORE A MILI-
- 8 TARY OFFICER PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION has the same force and
- 9 effect as -it would have had if AN INSTRUMENT sworn -to- OR
- 10 AFFIRMED before any of the officers now OFFICER authorized by
- 11 law to administer -caths and affirmations AN OATH OR
- 12 AFFIRMATION.
- 13 (5) (4) In cases where the IF AN acknowledgment is taken
- 14 before a military officer, the certificate shall be substantially
- 15 in the following form:
- 16 On this, the......day of, 19...., before me,
- 17, the undersigned officer, personally appeared,
- 18 known to me (or satisfactorily proven PROVED) to be serving in
- 19 or with the armed forces of the United States, (or to be OR WHO
- 20 IS KNOWN TO BE OR HAS SATISFACTORILY PROVED THAT HE OR SHE IS THE
- 21 DEPENDENT OF A MEMBER, a civilian employee of the armed forces --
- 22 or a dependent of a person serving in or with the armed forces or
- 23 of a civilian employee thereof) and to be OR THE DEPENDENT OF A
- 24 CIVILIAN EMPLOYEE, AND WHO IS the person whose name is subscribed
- 25 to the foregoing and made oath that he or she knows the
- 26 contents -thereof OF THE FOREGOING, and the -same FOREGOING is
- 27 true TO THE BEST of his -own OR HER knowledge, except as to

16	PUBLIC ACTS OF 1927, BEING SECTION 764.1 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED
