HOUSE BILL No. 4502

March 22, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Hoffman, Griffin and O'Neill and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the department of natural resources to convey certain state owned property in Jackson county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for the disposition of revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The department of natural resources shall convey to
- 2 the highest bidder for not less than fair market value as deter-
- 3 mined pursuant to section 3 certain parcels of property located
- 4 in Jackson county and described as follows:
- 5 (a) Lots 61 and 62, Steve's Scenic Subdivision Extension
- 6 No. 1, being part of Sec. 30, T4S, R1W, and Sec. 25, T4S, R2W -
- 7 Jackson County.
- 8 (b) Lot 63, Steve's Scenic Subdivision Extension No. 1,
- 9 being part of Sec. 30, T4S, RIW, and Sec. 25, T4S, R2W Jackson

- 1 Sec. 2. It is the intent of the legislature that the
- 2 parcels of properly described in section 1 be placed on the
- 3 market for sale within 30 days after the effective date of this
- 4 act, and sold as soon as possible thereafter.
- 5 Sec. 3. The fair market value of the property described in
- 6 section 1 shall be determined by an appraisal based on the
- 7 property's highest and best use, as prepared by an independent
- 8 appraiser and reviewed by an independent review appraiser.
- 9 Sec. 4. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
- 10 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general, and shall
- 11 reserve to the state rights to all coal, oil, gas, and metallic
- 12 minerals found on, within, or under the property.
- 13 Sec. 5. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 14 ited in the state treasury and credited to the Michigan natural
