## **HOUSE BILL No. 4561**

April 10, 1989, Introduced by Rep. Martin and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 7 of Act No. 357 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled

"An act to prescribe the powers, duties and functions of the state officers' compensation commission; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the legislature in relation to the commission."

being section 15.217 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 7 of Act No. 357 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1968, being section 15.217 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 7. The determinations of the commission shall be NOT
- 5 BECOME effective -January 1 of the year following their filing
- 6 and shall be the compensation and expense allowances of the gov-
- 7 ernor, lieutenant governor, justices of the supreme court and
- 8 members of the legislature unless UNTIL the legislature, by

- 1 concurrent resolution adopted by a 2/3 vote of the members
- 2 elected to and serving prior to February 1 of the year following
- 3 the filing of the determinations, -rejects APPROVES either the
- 4 entire determinations or specific determinations for specific

- 6 allowances shall prevail retroactive to January 1. IF THE LEGIS-
- 7 LATURE DOES NOT APPROVE THE ENTIRE DETERMINATIONS OR SPECIFIC
- 8 DETERMINATIONS FOR SPECIFIC POSITIONS BY FEBRUARY 1 OF THE YEAR
- 9 FOLLOWING THE FILING OF THE DETERMINATIONS, THE EXISTING SALARY
- 10 AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES FOR THE DETERMINATIONS NOT APPROVED SHALL
- 11 REMAIN IN EFFECT. IF THE LEGISLATURE APPROVES THE ENTIRE DETER-
- 12 MINATIONS OR SPECIFIC DETERMINATIONS FOR SPECIFIC POSITIONS BY
- 13 FEBRUARY 1 OF THE YEAR FOLLOWING THE FILING OF THE DETERMINA-
- 14 TIONS, THE DETERMINATIONS OF THE COMMISSION APPROVED SHALL BE
- 15 EFFECTIVE RETROACTIVE TO JANUARY 1 OF THE YEAR FOLLOWING THE
- 16 FILING OF THE DETERMINATIONS AND SHALL BE THE COMPENSATION AND
- 17 EXPENSE ALLOWANCES OF THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, JUSTICES
- 18 OF THE SUPREME COURT, AND MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE.
- 19 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 20 Senate Joint Resolution \_\_\_\_ or House Joint Resolution
- 21 (request no. 02058'89) of the 85th Legislature becomes a part of
- 22 the constitution as provided in section 1 of article XII of the
- 23 state constitution of 1963.
