

HOUSE BILL No. 4580

April 10, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Terrell, Clack, DeMars, Hunter, Stallworth, Honigman, Bennane, Harrison, Leland, Joe Young, Sr., Webb, Kilpatrick, Power, Sikkema, Martin and Bandstra and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 3 of chapter I of Act No. 146 of the
Public Acts of 1925, entitled

"An act to revise and consolidate the laws relating to the relief and support of poor persons; to prescribe penalties for violations of certain provisions of this act, and to repeal certain acts relating to poor persons,"

as amended by Act No. 313 of the Public Acts of 1980, being
section 401.3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of chapter I of Act No. 146 of the
2 Public Acts of 1925, as amended by Act No. 313 of the Public Acts
3 of 1980, being section 401.3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 CHAPTER I

6 Sec. 3. Upon the failure of ~~any~~ A relative of a poor
7 person to relieve and maintain the poor person, the county

1 department of social services in the county in which the poor
2 person resides ~~—~~ shall apply, with the advice and assistance of
3 the prosecuting attorney to the ~~probate~~ DOMESTIC RELATIONS
4 court of the county where the poor person or relative dwells or
5 the poor person has a legal settlement, for an order to compel
6 the relief. Upon application for an order to compel relief,
7 notice shall be given to necessary parties, as provided by law.

8 Section 2. This amendatory act shall take effect January 1,
9 1990.

10 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
11 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4567 (request
12 no. 01659'89) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
