## **HOUSE BILL No. 4634**

April 13, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Berman and Munsell and referred to the Committee on Taxation.

A bill to amend Act No. 122 of the Public Acts of 1941, entitled as amended

"An act to establish a revenue division of the department of treasury; to prescribe its powers and duties as the revenue collection agency of the state; to prescribe certain powers and duties of the state treasurer; to create the position and to define the powers and duties of the state commissioner of revenue; to provide for the transfer of powers and duties now vested in certain other state boards, commissions, departments and offices; to prescribe certain duties of and require certain reports from the department of treasury; to provide procedures for the payment, administration, audit, assessment, levy of interests or penalties on, and appeals of taxes and tax liability; to provide an appropriation; to abolish the state board of tax administration; and to declare the effect of this act,"

as amended, being sections 205.1 to 205.31 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 16.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 16 to read as follows:

- SEC. 16. BEGINNING IN THE YEAR 1990 AND EVERY 5 YEARS AFTER 1
- 2 1990, THE COMMITTEES HAVING JURISDICTION OVER TAXATION IN THE
- 3 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE SHALL REVIEW ALL DEDUC-
- 4 TIONS, EXEMPTIONS, CREDITS, ADJUSTMENTS, AND DIFFERENTIAL RATES
- 5 APPLICABLE TO EACH TAX THAT IS ADMINISTERED UNDER THIS ACT TO
- 6 DETERMINE WHETHER THE DEDUCTION, EXEMPTION, CREDIT, ADJUSTMENT,
- 7 OR DIFFERENTIAL RATE CONTINUES TO SERVE ITS ORIGINAL PURPOSE IN
- 8 AN EFFICIENT MANNER. THE TAX ACTS ADMINISTERED UNDER THIS ACT
- 9 MAY BE STAGGERED FOR REVIEW DURING 1990 AND 1991. THE COMMITTEES
- 10 SHALL USE THE INFORMATION RECEIVED UNDER ACT NO. 72 OF THE PUBLIC
- 11 ACTS OF 1979, BEING SECTIONS 21.271 TO 21.296 OF THE MICHIGAN
- 12 COMPILED LAWS, IN THEIR DELIBERATIONS.
