A bill to amend section 804 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended by Act No. 238 of the Public Acts of 1987, being section 257.804 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 803i.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 804 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1949, as amended by Act No. 238 of the Public Acts of 1987, being
- 3 section 257.804 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and
- 4 section 803i is added to read as follows:
- 5 SEC. 8031. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY ISSUE 2 SPECIAL
- 6 ORGANIZATION MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES TO AN APPLICANT
- 7 FOR USE ON A PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE, PICKUP TRUCK, VAN, OR MOTOR
- 8 HOME FOR WHICH THE PLATES ARE ISSUED INSTEAD OF STANDARD PLATES.

- 1 A SPECIAL ORGANIZATION MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATE IS A
- 2 REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE THAT BEARS ON
- 3 ITS FACE THE SYMBOL OR EMBLEM OF AN ORGANIZATION.
- 4 (2) SPECIAL ORGANIZATION PLATES SHALL BEAR LETTERS AND NUM-
- 5 BERS AS THE SECRETARY OF STATE PRESCRIBES. SPECIAL ORGANIZATION
- 6 PLATES MAY CONTAIN THE SYMBOL OF THE ORGANIZATION TO THE LEFT OF
- 7 THE PLATE NUMBER AND THE NAME OF THE ORGANIZATION IMMEDIATELY
- 8 ABOVE THE PLATE NUMBER. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT ISSUE A
- 9 LETTER COMBINATION WHICH MIGHT CARRY A CONNOTATION OFFENSIVE TO
- 10 GOOD TASTE AND DECENCY. THE SPECIAL ORGANIZATION PLATES SHALL BE
- 11 MADE OF THE SAME MATERIAL AS STANDARD PLATES. SPECIAL ORGANI-
- 12 ZATION PLATES SHALL NOT BE A DUPLICATION OF ANOTHER REGISTRATION
- 13 PLATE.
- 14 (3) IN ORDER TO QUALIFY ITS MEMBERS TO RECEIVE SPECIAL ORGA-
- 15 NIZATION PLATES, AN ORGANIZATION SHALL MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 16 CRITERIA:
- 17 (A) BE A NONPROFIT FRATERNAL OR PUBLIC SERVICE
- 18 ORGANIZATION.
- 19 (B) CERTIFY THAT IT CONSISTS OF NOT LESS THAN 500 MEMBERS
- 20 AND THAT NOT LESS THAN 500 MEMBERS WILL APPLY FOR SPECIAL ORGANI-
- 21 ZATION REGISTRATION PLATES.
- 22 (C) HAVE A RECOGNIZABLE STATE, NATIONAL, OR INTERNATIONAL
- 23 SYMBOL OR EMBLEM OF THE ORGANIZATION.
- 24 (D) SUBMIT A SERVICE FEE OF \$250.00 FOR THE INITIAL MANUFAC-
- 25 TURE OF THE SYMBOLS OR EMBLEMS FOR THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION
- 26 PLATES.

- (4) IF AN ORGANIZATION MEETS THE CRITERIA SET FORTH IN
- 2 SUBSECTION (3), THE ORGANIZATION MAY REQUEST THE SECRETARY OF
- 3 STATE TO MANUFACTURE SPECIAL ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION PLATES FOR
- 4 ITS MEMBERS. A REQUEST SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY ALL OF THE
- 5 FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) A COPY OF THE ORGANIZATION'S CHARTER AND BYLAWS, IF 7 ANY.
- 8 (B) A STATEMENT OF THE ORGANIZATION'S CONSENT TO USE OF THE
- 9 ORGANIZATION'S SYMBOL OR EMBLEM ON SPECIAL ORGANIZATION PLATES.
- 10 THE STATEMENT SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE PRESIDENT OR CHIEF EXECUTIVE
- 11 OFFICER OF THE ORGANIZATION.
- 12 (C) A SAMPLE OF THE ORGANIZATION'S SYMBOL OR EMBLEM.
- 13 (D) THE NAME OF THE ORGANIZATION'S REPRESENTATIVE WHO WILL
- 14 SERVE AS A CONTACT PERSON WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
- 15 (5) A MEMBER OF AN ORGANIZATION WHICH HAS MET THE CRITERIA
- 16 SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (3) SHALL INDIVIDUALLY MAKE APPLICATION
- 17 FOR A SPECIAL ORGANIZATION PLATE AND SUBMIT WITH THE APPLICATION
- 18 THE ORGANIZATION'S CONFIRMATION OF MEMBERSHIP ON A FORM PROVIDED
- 19 BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
- 20 (6) AN APPLICATION FOR A SPECIAL ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION
- 21 PLATE SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE PURSUANT TO
- 22 THE PROCEDURES PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 217. IN ADDITION TO THE
- 23 REGULAR REGISTRATION FEE, EACH APPLICATION FOR A NEW SPECIAL
- 24 ORGANIZATION PLATE SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A SERVICE FEE OF
- 25 \$25.00. THE SERVICE FEE PRESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT
- 26 BE CHARGED IN CONNECTION WITH AN APPLICATION FOR A RENEWAL TAB
- 27 FOR AN EXISTING SPECIAL ORGANIZATION PLATE. A SPECIAL

- 1 ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL EXPIRE AS PROVIDED IN
- 2 SECTION 226.
- 3 (7) EACH SERVICE FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
- 4 DEPOSITED IN THE STATE TREASURY AND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE
- 5 MICHIGAN TRANSPORTATION FUND. AFTER DEDUCTING MANUFACTURING AND
- 6 ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS, THE SERVICE FEES SHALL BE ALLOCATED PURSU-
- 7 ANT TO SECTION 10 OF ACT NO. 51 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1951, BEING
- 8 SECTION 247.660 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
- 9 (8) THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY ISSUE A TEMPORARY REGISTRA-
- 10 TION PERMIT TO A PERSON WHO SUBMITS AN APPLICATION AND THE PROPER
- 11 FEES FOR A SPECIAL ORGANIZATION PLATE, IF THE APPLICANT'S CURRENT
- 12 VEHICLE REGISTRATION WILL EXPIRE BEFORE HIS OR HER RECEIPT OF AN
- 13 ORGANIZATION PLATE. THE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION SHALL EXPIRE UPON
- 14 THE APPLICANT'S RECEIPT OF AN ORGANIZATION PLATE OR UPON THE
- 15 EXPIRATION OF 60 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE, WHICHEVER
- 16 OCCURS FIRST. A TEMPORARY PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 17 SHALL BE ISSUED WITHOUT CHARGE.
- 18 Sec. 804. A fee of \$5.00 shall be paid with each applica-
- 19 tion for a duplicate or replacement license plate provided for in
- 20 section 229. A FEE OF \$10.00 SHALL BE PAID WITH EACH APPLICATION
- 21 FOR A DUPLICATE OR REPLACEMENT SET OF PLATES PROVIDED FOR IN SEC-
- 22 TION 803I.
