

HOUSE BILL No. 4682

April 20, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Crandall, Bandstra, Krause, Bender, Randall, Stacey, London, Fitzgerald, Miller, Gnodtke, Munsell, Stabenow, Hertel, DeMars, Gire, Wallace, Leland, Knight, Johnson, Gilmer, Ostling, Gubow, Dolan and Nye and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended
"Public health code,"
as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 2841a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 2841a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 2841A. (1) A DEATH CERTIFICATE PRESCRIBED BY THE
6 DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION 2811 SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING QUES-
7 TION AND ALL OF THE RESPONSES LISTED IN SUBSECTION (2):

1 "DID TOBACCO USE CONTRIBUTE TO THE DEATH?"

2 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL REQUIRED UNDER THIS PART TO COMPLETE AND
3 SIGN A DEATH CERTIFICATE SHALL ANSWER THE QUESTION SET FORTH IN
4 SUBSECTION (1) BY CHECKING A BOX CORRESPONDING TO 1 OF THE FOL-
5 LOWING RESPONSES:

6 (A) YES.

7 (B) NO.

8 (C) PROBABLY.

9 (D) UNKNOWN.
