- 1 CERTIFICATE FOR AT LEAST 90 CONSECUTIVE DAYS MAY ELECT TO CONVERT
- 2 TO AN INDIVIDUAL CERTIFICATE WITH THE SAME COVERAGE AS WAS PRO-
- 3 VIDED IN THE GROUP CERTIFICATE.
- 4 (3) A PERSON WHO ELECTS TO CONVERT TO AN INDIVIDUAL CERTIFI-

- 6 (6) BY JANUARY 1, 1990, A MASTER CERTIFICATEHOLDER SHALL
- 7 NOTIFY ALL GROUP SUBSCRIBERS AND THEIR SPOUSES AND DEPENDENT
- 8 CHILDREN OF THE RIGHT TO ELECT TO CONVERT TO AN INDIVIDUAL
- 9 CERTIFICATE.
- 10 (7) A MASTER CERTIFICATEHOLDER SHALL NOTIFY EACH NEW GROUP
- 11 SUBSCRIBER, SUBSCRIBER'S SPOUSE, AND SUBSCRIBER'S DEPENDENT CHIL-
- 12 DREN OF THE RIGHT TO ELECT TO CONVERT TO AN INDIVIDUAL
- 13 CERTIFICATE.
- 14 (8) A MASTER CERTIFICATEHOLDER SHALL NOTIFY EACH SUBSCRIBER,
- 15 SUBSCRIBER'S SPOUSE, AND SUBSCRIBER'S DEPENDENT CHILD OF THEIR
- 16 RIGHT TO AN ELECTION UNDER THIS SECTION AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE
- 17 THE GROUP CEASES TO EXIST.
- 18 (9) A SUBSCRIBER, SUBSCRIBER'S SPOUSE, OR SUBSCRIBER'S
- 19 DEPENDENT CHILD SHALL NOTIFY THE MASTER CERTIFICATEHOLDER OR, IF
- 20 THE GROUP CEASES TO EXIST, THE HEALTH CARE CORPORATION OF AN
- 21 ELECTION UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 22 (10) A MASTER CERTIFICATEHOLDER SHALL NOTIFY THE HEALTH CARE
- 23 CORPORATION OF A PERSON'S ELECTION UNDER THIS SECTION. THE
- 24 NOTICE SHALL BE GIVEN NOT LATER THAN 7 DAYS AFTER THE MASTER CER-
- 25 TIFICATEHOLDER RECEIVES THE NOTICE PROVIDED FOR IN
- 26 SUBSECTION (9).

- 1 (11) THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO INTERFERE WITH
- 2 OR DIMINISH ANY PROTECTION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO A COLLECTIVE
- 3 BARGAINING AGREEMENT OR AN EMPLOYER-SPONSORED HEALTH PLAN THAT IS
- 4 MORE FAVORABLE TO A SUBSCRIBER, SUBSCRIBER'S SPOUSE, OR
- 5 SUBSCRIBER'S DEPENDENT CHILD BENEFITED UNDER THE AGREEMENT OR
- 6 PLAN THAN THE PROTECTION OFFERED BY THIS SECTION.
