

HOUSE BILL No. 4706

April 26, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Owen, Bartnik, Hoffman, Joe Young, Sr., Bennane, DeMars, Profit, Stallworth, Sofio, Wallace, Saunders, Jacobetti, Palamara, Varga, Kilpatrick, Perry Bullard, Clack, Webb, Kosteva, Law, Trim, Hickner, Hunter and Watkins and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend the title and section 7 of Act No. 166 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled

"An act to require prevailing wages and fringe benefits on state projects; to establish the requirements and responsibilities of contracting agents and bidders; and to prescribe penalties,"

being section 408.557 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. The title and section 7 of Act No. 166 of the
2 Public Acts of 1965, being section 408.557 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

4 TITLE

5 An act to require prevailing wages and fringe benefits on
6 state projects; to establish the requirements and responsibili-
7 ties of contracting agents and bidders; and to prescribe REMEDIES
8 AND penalties.

1 Sec. 7. (1) Any person, firm, or corporation or combination
2 thereof, including the officers of any contracting agent,
3 ~~violating the provisions of~~ THAT VIOLATES this act is guilty of
4 a misdemeanor. IN ADDITION, A CONTRACTOR THAT VIOLATES THIS ACT
5 IS PROHIBITED FROM BIDDING ON ANY STATE PROJECTS FOR 2 YEARS
6 AFTER THE DATE OF THE CONVICTION.

7 (2) A CONTRACTOR THAT IS GUILTY OF A VIOLATION OF THIS ACT
8 MAY BE REQUIRED TO PAY TO EACH CONSTRUCTION MECHANIC THE DIFFER-
9 ENCE BETWEEN THE PREVAILING WAGE IN THE LOCALITY OF THE STATE
10 PROJECT AND THE ACTUAL WAGES PAID.
