

HOUSE BILL No. 4747

May 1, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Watkins, DeMars, Joe Young, Sr., Wallace, Joe Young, Jr. and Profit and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 217 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended

"Electrical administrative act,"

as amended by Act No. 430 of the Public Acts of 1982, being section 338.883 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 217 of the Public Acts of
2 1956, as amended by Act No. 430 of the Public Acts of 1982, being
3 section 338.883 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 3. (1) The board shall grant annual licenses and cer-
6 tificates to qualified applicants, make orders and promulgate
7 rules necessary ~~to~~ FOR the enforcement and carrying out of this
8 act, and enforce and carry out this act. The rules shall be
9 promulgated pursuant to THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF

1 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended, being
 2 sections 24.201 to ~~24.315~~ 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled
 3 Laws.

4 (2) ~~Before a license is granted to an applicant and before~~
 5 ~~an expiring license is renewed, the applicant shall pay a fee~~
 6 ~~annually as specified for the class of license to be granted or~~
 7 ~~renewed in the following amounts:~~ THE EXAMINATION FEE FOR LICEN-
 8 SURE AS A MASTER ELECTRICIAN OR A JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN SHALL BE
 9 \$25.00.

10 (3) THE FEE FOR INITIAL LICENSURE OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE
 11 ISSUED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

12 (A) ~~Class 1~~ Electrical ~~contractor's license~~
 13 CONTRACTOR.....\$75.00
 14 (B) ~~Class 2~~ Master ~~electrician's license~~
 15 ELECTRICIAN..... 25.00
 16 ~~Class 3~~ Journeyman's license..... ~~15.00~~
 17 (C) JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN..... 20.00

18 (4) A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL EXPIRE ON
 19 DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR AND IS RENEWABLE NOT MORE THAN 60 DAYS
 20 AFTER THAT DATE UPON APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF THE APPROPRIATE
 21 FEE AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (3).

22 (5) AFTER MARCH 1 OF EACH YEAR, A LICENSE NOT RENEWED SHALL
 23 BE CONSIDERED VOID AND MAY BE REINSTATED ONLY UPON APPLICATION
 24 FOR REINSTATEMENT AND PAYMENT OF THE REINSTATEMENT LICENSE FEE
 25 FOR THE APPROPRIATE CLASS. THE REINSTATEMENT LICENSE FEES ARE AS
 26 FOLLOWS:

1 (A) ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR.....\$85.00
 2 (B) MASTER ELECTRICIAN..... 35.00
 3 (C) JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN..... 25.00

4 (6) ~~(3)~~ In addition to the fee required by subsection (2),
 5 a person applying for an electrical contractor's license shall
 6 also pay any amount required to be paid under THE CONSTRUCTION
 7 LIEN ACT, Act No. 497 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended,
 8 being sections 570.1101 to 570.1305 of the Michigan Compiled
 9 Laws, which amount shall be paid to the department of licensing
 10 and regulation for deposit in the homeowner construction lien
 11 recovery fund.

12 (7) ~~(4)~~ An electrical contractor shall ~~qualify for~~ HOLD
 13 a master electrician's license. ~~or have not less than 1 master~~
 14 ~~electrician in his or her employ who shall be actively in charge~~
 15 ~~of all installations.~~

16 (8) ~~(5)~~ A person who is licensed by a municipality under
 17 section 6 may obtain a license from the board without the taking
 18 of an examination upon the payment of the appropriate fees under
 19 subsections ~~(2)~~ (3) and ~~(3)~~ (6).
