

HOUSE BILL No. 4750

May 3, 1989, Introduced by Rep. Scott and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 508 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
being section 750.508 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 508 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of
2 1931, being section 750.508 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 508. Any person who shall equip a vehicle with a
5 radio receiving set that will receive signals sent on frequencies
6 assigned by the federal communications commission of the United
7 States of America for police purposes, or use the same in this
8 state unless such vehicle is used or owned by a peace officer, or
9 a bona fide amateur radio operator holding a conditional,
10 TECHNICIAN CLASS, general, advanced, or extra class amateur

1 license issued by the federal communications commission, without
2 first securing a permit so to do from the ~~commissioner of the~~
3 ~~Michigan~~ DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF state police upon ~~such~~
4 application as he OR SHE may prescribe, shall be guilty of a mis-
5 demeanor, punishable by imprisonment in the county jail FOR not
6 more than 1 year, or by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by
7 both ~~such~~ fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the
8 court.
