- 4 Sec. 1. In the prosecution of any complaint or indictment
- 5 charging a criminal offense, whether cognizable by a justice of
- 6 the peace or otherwise, no presumption shall be indulged that a
- 7 married woman committing an offense does so under coercion
- 8 because she commits it in the presence of her husband.
