

HOUSE BILL No. 4758

May 3, 1989, Introduced by Rep. Honigman and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 137 of the Public Acts of 1885, entitled

"An act making 10 hours a legal day's work,"

being section 408.403 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 137 of the Public Acts of
2 1885, being section 408.403 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3. Any individual, firm, agent of any corporation, or
5 other employers of labor who shall take any unlawful advantage of
6 any person or persons in their employ, or seeking employment,
7 because of their poverty or misfortune, to invalidate any of the
8 provisions of the preceding section, shall be deemed guilty of a
9 misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not
10 less than \$5.00, ~~dollars~~ nor more than \$50.00 ~~dollars~~ for

1 each offense, and it shall be the duty of the prosecuting
2 attorney of the county in which such offense was committed, upon
3 receiving complaint, to prosecute all such cases in the name of
4 the people of the state of Michigan, before ~~any justice of the~~
5 ~~peace or other competent~~ THE DISTRICT OR MUNICIPAL court ~~of~~
6 ~~jurisdiction~~ IN WHICH THE OFFENSE WAS COMMITTED.
