

# HOUSE BILL No. 4760

May 3, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Giese, Bartnik, Middaugh, Bender, Randall, Strand, Ostling, Van Singel, Pridnia, Power and Alley and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Fisheries and Wildlife.

A bill to amend sections 204 and 305 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled "The hunting and fishing license act," section 305 as amended by Act No. 63 of the Public Acts of 1986, being sections 316.204 and 316.305 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Sections 204 and 305 of Act No. 86 of the Public  
2 Acts of 1980, section 305 as amended by Act No. 63 of the Public  
3 Acts of 1986, being sections 316.204 and 316.305 of the Michigan  
4 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

5       Sec. 204. A person shall not carry ~~any firearms~~ A FIREARM  
6 or a bow and arrow while in any area open for wild turkey hunting  
7 during the spring wild turkey hunting season, unless the person

1 possesses a valid turkey license ~~and small game license~~ ISSUED  
2 UNDER SECTION 306.

3       Sec. 305. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this act, a  
4 person shall not hunt small game without a current small game  
5 license. Each small game license shall authorize the person  
6 named in the license to hunt for small game except for animals or  
7 birds which require a special license. The fee for a resident  
8 small game license shall be ~~\$7.00. Beginning on April 1, 1987,~~  
9 ~~the fee for a resident small game license shall be~~ \$9.50. The  
10 fee for a nonresident small game license shall be ~~\$35.00.~~  
11 ~~Beginning on April 1, 1986, the fee for a nonresident small game~~  
12 ~~license shall be~~ \$50.00. The resident small game license fee  
13 for a minor child shall be 1/2 the amount prescribed in this  
14 subsection.

15       (2) A nonresident may purchase a limited small game license  
16 entitling that person to hunt for a 3-day period all species of  
17 small game that are available to hunt under the small game  
18 license. The fee for the limited nonresident small game license  
19 shall be \$20.00.

20       (3) A small game license shall be void between the hours of  
21 sunset and sunrise.

22       (4) A nonresident hunter who legally possesses a nonresident  
23 hunting license may take from this state as open hand baggage the  
24 number of birds and animals which are permitted to be taken and  
25 in the person's possession at any 1 time.

26       (5) WILD TURKEY MAY BE TAKEN DURING THE OPEN SEASON FOR WILD  
27 TURKEY WITH A VALID WILD TURKEY HUNTING LICENSE ISSUED UNDER

1 SECTION 306. A SMALL GAME LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IS  
2 NOT REQUIRED TO TAKE WILD TURKEY.
