

# HOUSE BILL No. 4792

May 10, 1989, Introduced by Rep. Perry Bullard and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 6 of Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of 1855, entitled as amended

"An act relative to burying grounds; and to impose certain duties upon the department of commerce,"

being section 456.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 6 of Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of  
2 1855, being section 456.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 6. Upon application in writing of any 3 of the persons  
5 aforesaid to ~~any justice of the peace of the county~~ THE DIS-  
6 TRICT OR MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT OR MUNICIPALITY  
7 in which such burying ground is to be situated, ~~he~~ THE COURT  
8 shall issue ~~his~~ A warrant to either one of ~~said~~ THE  
9 applicants, directing him OR HER to call a meeting of the persons

1 wishing to become incorporated, which warrant shall contain the  
2 substance of the application, and shall state the time and place  
3 of holding the meeting. ~~and such~~ THE meeting shall be  
4 called in obedience to such warrant, by posting up notice  
5 ~~thereof~~ containing the substance of the warrant in at least 2  
6 public places in the township, city, or village, in which such  
7 burying ground is to be situated at least 10 days before the time  
8 of holding such meeting.
