

# HOUSE BILL No. 4796

May 10, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Spaniola and Hertel and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 73 of the Public Acts of 1970, entitled

"An act to provide for the creation of airport authorities; to provide for certain counties and cities within certain limitations of state-owned airports to create an airport authority; to provide for the membership of authorities; to provide for the powers and duties of the authorities; to provide for the transfer of employees of state airports to the employment of an authority; to provide for the transferring of state-owned lands to the authority; to provide for the retention of certain rights, powers and privileges by the state in state-owned airport facilities; to provide for a referendum; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

as amended by Act No. 271 of the Public Acts of 1982, being section 259.802 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 73 of the Public Acts of  
2 1970, as amended by Act No. 271 of the Public Acts of 1982, being  
3 section 259.802 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read  
4 as follows:

1       Sec. 2. The authority shall be directed and governed by an  
2 airport authority board, hereafter referred to as the "board".  
3 The board shall consist of THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT  
4 OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AERONAUTICS; 3 members from each city des-  
5 ignated in section 1, appointed by the mayor with the advice and  
6 consent of the council; 2 members from the balance of each county  
7 having a city of over 100,000 located primarily within its bound-  
8 aries, appointed by a majority of the county board of commission-  
9 ers; and 2 members from each other county comprising the authori-  
10 ty, appointed by their respective legislative bodies by a major-  
11 ity of the full membership of the appointing legislative body. A  
12 board member shall be an elector of their respective appointing  
13 city or county and may be a member of the appointing legislative  
14 body.
