THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 114 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1967, as amended by Act No. 189 of the Public Acts of 1987, being
- 3 section 281.1114 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 114. (1) A person shall not operate a motorboat on the
- 6 waters of this state unless the motorboat is equipped AND
- 7 MAINTAINED with -a- AN EFFECTIVE muffler OR underwater
- 8 exhaust , or other modern noise reduction device that is in good
- 9 working order and in constant operation. Noise emission,

- 1 measured at not less than 50 feet from a motorboat, shall not
- 2 exceed 86 decibels on the "A" scale on a sound meter having char-
- 3 acteristics of a general purpose sound meter as defined by
- 4 American national standards institute S1.4 1983 SYSTEM.
- 5 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT OPERATE A MOTORBOAT ON THE WATERS OF
- 6 THIS STATE IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO EXCEED A NOISE LEVEL OF 75dB(A)
- 7 MEASURED AS SPECIFIED IN SAE J1970 OF THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STAN-
- 8 DARDS INSTITUTE FROM ANY POINT ON THE SHORELINE OF THE BODY OF
- 9 WATER ON WHICH THE MOTORBOAT IS BEING OPERATED.
- 10 (3) A person shall not operate on the waters of this state a
- 11 motorboat that is equipped with a cut-out, bypass, amplifier, or
- 12 other similar device. A person shall not operate a motorboat on
- 13 the waters of this state in a manner that disturbs the peace of

- 15 (4) SOUND level limitations prescribed in this section
- 16 SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) shall not apply to the Great Lakes.

- 19 (A) A MOTORBOAT TUNING UP, TESTING FOR OR PARTICIPATING IN

- 23 (B) A MOTORBOAT BEING OPERATED BY A BOAT OR MARINE ENGINE
- 24 MANUFACTURER FOR THE PURPOSE OF TESTING OR DEVELOPMENT.
- 25 (6) A PERSON SHALL NOT MANUFACTURE OR OFFER FOR SALE ANY
- 26 MOTORBOAT FOR USE ON THE WATERS OF THIS STATE IF THAT MOTORBOAT

- I CANNOT BE OPERATED IN SUCH A MANNER SO AS TO COMPLY WITH THE
- 2 SOUND LEVELS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2).
- 3 (7) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDE-
- 4 MEANOR, PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS AND
- 5 A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$100.00 OR MORE THAN \$500.00.
- 6 ADDITIONALLY, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION MAY BE REQUIRED
- 7 TO INSTALL AN EFFECTIVE MUFFLER OR UNDERWATER EXHAUST SYSTEM ON
- 8 THE MOTORBOAT IN VIOLATION AT HIS OR HER EXPENSE, AND MAY BE
- 9 REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A BOATING SAFETY COURSE.
- 10 (8) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, AN "EFFECTIVE MUFFLER OR UNDER-
- 11 WATER EXHAUST SYSTEM" IS ONE WHICH DOES NOT PRODUCE SOUND LEVELS
- 12 IN EXCESS OF 90 dB(A) WHEN SUBJECTED TO A STATIONARY SOUND LEVEL
- 13 TEST AS PRESCRIBED BY SAE J2005 OF THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STAN-
- 14 DARDS INSTITUTE.
- 15 Section 2. This amendatory act shall take effect upon the
- 16 expiration of 90 days after the date of its enactment.
