

# HOUSE BILL No. 4840

May 18, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Hertel, Stupak, DeMars, Palamara, Maynard and Bartnik and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 1702 of Act No. 268 of the Public Acts of 1986, entitled as amended  
"Legislative council act,"  
as added by Act No. 123 of the Public Acts of 1987, being section 4.1702 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1702 of Act No. 268 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1986, as added by Act No. 123 of the Public Acts of 1987,  
3 being section 4.1702 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 Sec. 1702. (1) The Michigan capitol committee shall advise  
6 and make recommendations to the governor, the senate majority  
7 leader, and the speaker of the house of representatives regarding  
8 the restoration and preservation of the state capitol building  
9 and the management, operation, development, construction,

1 renovation, maintenance, and repair of the state capitol building  
2 and grounds. Such recommendations shall take effect 15 days  
3 after the submission to the governor, senate majority leader, and  
4 speaker of the house of representatives unless rejected in writ-  
5 ing by the governor, senate majority leader, or speaker of the  
6 house of representatives.

7 (2) In carrying out the powers and duties prescribed under  
8 subsection (1), the Michigan capitol committee shall do all of  
9 the following:

10 (a) Develop and recommend written procedures for the opera-  
11 tion of the Michigan capitol committee.

12 (b) Make recommendations to the governor, the majority  
13 leader of the senate, and the speaker of the house of representa-  
14 tives regarding the implementation of all permanent physical  
15 changes to be made in or on the capitol building and all physical  
16 changes to be made on the grounds of the capitol building.

17 (c) Make recommendations to the governor, the majority  
18 leader of the senate, and the speaker of the house of representa-  
19 tives regarding the implementation of a state capitol building  
20 master plan.

21 (d) Make recommendations to the governor, the majority  
22 leader of the senate, and the speaker of the house of representa-  
23 tives regarding public and private financial support for the  
24 development, construction, renovation, and preservation of the  
25 capitol building and grounds.

26 (e) Make recommendations to the governor, the majority  
27 leader of the senate, and the speaker of the house of

1 representatives regarding the selection, design, and placement of  
2 statues, memorials, trees, and plants on the grounds of the capi-  
3 tol building.

4 (3) The Michigan capitol committee shall have powers which  
5 are necessary or appropriate to perform the duties and exercise  
6 the powers prescribed under this chapter and which are not other-  
7 wise prohibited by law, including:

8 (a) Contracting with the department of management and budget  
9 or any other public or private entity.

10 (b) Appointing advisory committees.

11 (4) The current labor and trades and safety and regulatory  
12 classifications performing duties on the capitol premises shall  
13 be maintained.

14 (5) The Michigan capitol committee shall not have authority  
15 ~~nor~~ OR exercise control over the internal decisions of the  
16 senate or the house of representatives as they relate to the  
17 allocation of space in the capitol building and on the grounds,  
18 including legislative or staff offices. All decisions concerning  
19 such space shall be made according to the rules or practices of  
20 the respective bodies.

21 (6) THE MICHIGAN CAPITOL COMMITTEE SHALL NOT HAVE AUTHORITY  
22 OR EXERCISE CONTROL OVER THE SELECTION, DESIGN, OR CONSTRUCTION,  
23 OR THE FINANCING FOR THE SELECTION, DESIGN, OR CONSTRUCTION, OF  
24 THE MICHIGAN POLICE OFFICERS MEMORIAL MONUMENT TO BE LOCATED ON  
25 THE GROUNDS PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN POLICE OFFICERS MEMORIAL  
26 ACT, BUT SHALL HAVE AUTHORITY OVER THE MICHIGAN POLICE OFFICERS  
27 MEMORIAL MONUMENT AFTER ITS CONSTRUCTION, INCLUDING, BUT NO.

1 LIMITED TO, THE ADDITION OF THE NAMES OF MICHIGAN POLICE OFFICERS  
2 KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY AS IDENTIFIED BY THE OFFICE OF CRIMI-  
3 NAL JUSTICE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET.

4 (7) ~~(6)~~ As used in this section, "grounds" means the prop-  
5 erty upon which the state capitol building is situated, bordered  
6 on the north by Ottawa street; on the east by Capitol avenue; on  
7 the south by Allegan street; and on the west by Walnut street.

8 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
9 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ of House Bill No. 4838 (request  
10 no. 03103'89) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
