THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 2, 5, and 14 of Act No. 361 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1978, being sections 285.162, 285.165, and 285.174
- 3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 5 (a) "Council" means the state exposition and fairgrounds
- 6 council created in section 9.
- 7 (b) "Department" means the state department of natural
- 8 resources AGRICULTURE.

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- (c) "Director" means the director of the department.
- 2 (d) "Manager" means the manager of the state exposition and 3 fairgrounds.
- 4 Sec. 5. The control of all land and other property vested
- 5 in the state or its people for the purpose of holding and con-
- 6 ducting agricultural and industrial fairs and exhibitions, is
- 7 transferred from the department of -agriculture NATURAL
- 8 RESOURCES and vested in the department.
- 9 Sec. 14. All classified fair employees of the -state-
- 10 department of -agriculture NATURAL RESOURCES are transferred to
- 11 the department and shall be considered to have continuous employ-
- 12 ment under the civil service commission and shall retain all ben-
- 13 efits and rights which have accrued to them.
