

HOUSE BILL No. 4857

May 22, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Brown, Gilmer, Jondahl, Miller, Hood and Sofio and referred to the Committee on Colleges and Universities.

A bill to amend section 5 of Act No. 288 of the Public Acts of 1986, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible postsecondary schools and employed by qualified employers; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

being section 390.1375 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Act No. 288 of the Public Acts of
2 1986, being section 390.1375 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 5. An employer ~~which~~ THAT is organized for nonprofit
5 purposes is eligible to employ students through the MWS program
6 if the employer meets all of the following requirements:

1 (a) Enters into a signed agreement with an eligible
2 postsecondary school to provide employment for students
3 recommended by the school.

4 (b) Provides at least 20% of the wages earned by the MWS
5 students.

6 (c) Does not use MWS students to displace employed workers.

7 (d) Does not employ MWS students to construct, operate, or
8 maintain a facility used, or to be used solely, for sectarian
9 instruction or as a place for religious worship. ~~, or other~~
10 ~~activity espousing a particular political or moral position.~~

11 (e) Does not pay MWS students a wage that is less than the
12 federal minimum wage.
