

HOUSE BILL No. 4864

May 23, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Bartnik, Krause, DeMars, Camp, Middaugh, Hertel, Hart, Niederstadt, Stupak, Weeks, Martin, Johnson, Owen and Profit and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Fisheries and Wildlife.

A bill to amend sections 802 and 805 of Act No. 86 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled
"The hunting and fishing license act,"
being sections 316.802 and 316.805 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 802 and 805 of Act No. 86 of the Public
2 Acts of 1980, being sections 316.802 and 316.805 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 802. (1) ~~During~~ EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUB-
5 SECTION (2), DURING a season open to the hunting of deer with bow
6 and arrow, a licensee shall not carry a pistol, revolver, or any
7 other firearm while bow hunting for deer.

8 (2) SUBSECTION (1) SHALL NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO CARRIES A
9 SHOTGUN AND HOLDS A VALID PERMIT TO TAKE DEER WITH A SHOTGUN

1 DURING THE SEASON OPEN TO THE HUNTING OF DEER WITH BOW AND ARROW
2 ISSUED UNDER SECTION 14(3) OF THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ACT, ACT
3 NO. 256 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1988, BEING SECTION 300.264 OF THE
4 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

5 Sec. 805. (1) ~~During~~ EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUB-
6 SECTION (2), DURING the 5 days immediately preceding the opening
7 of the earliest season for the taking of deer with firearms, a
8 person shall not transport or possess in any area frequented by
9 deer a rifle or shotgun with buckshot, slug load, ball load, or
10 cut shell. A person may transport a rifle or shotgun to or from
11 a hunting camp if the rifle or shotgun is unloaded and locked in
12 the trunk of a motor vehicle or otherwise inaccessible to an
13 occupant of the motor vehicle from the interior of the vehicle.

14 (2) SUBSECTION (1) SHALL NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO TRANS-
15 PORTS OR POSSESSES A SHOTGUN AND HOLDS A VALID PERMIT TO TAKE
16 DEER WITH A SHOTGUN DURING THE SEASON OPEN TO THE HUNTING OF DEER
17 WITH BOW AND ARROW ISSUED UNDER SECTION 14(3) OF THE WILDLIFE
18 CONSERVATION ACT, ACT NO. 256 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1988, BEING
19 SECTION 300.264 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

20 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
21 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4863 (request
22 no. 02940'89) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
