

HOUSE BILL No. 4943

June 27, 1989, Introduced by Reps. DeLange, Gnodtke, Weeks, Krause, Stacey, Dunaskiss, Van Singel, Munsell, DeMars, Emmons, Muxlow and Pitoniak and referred to the Committee on Taxation.

A bill to repeal Act No. 243 of the Public Acts of 1959, entitled:

"An act to define, license and regulate trailer coach parks; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state health commissioner and other state and local officers; to provide for the levy and collection of specific taxes on occupied trailers in trailer coach parks and the disposition of the revenues therefrom; to provide remedies and penalties for the violation of this act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

being sections 125.1035 to 125.1043 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 243 of the Public Acts of 1959, being
2 sections 125.1035 to 125.1043 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 repealed.

4 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
5 all of the following bills of the 85th Legislature are enacted
6 into law:
