

# HOUSE BILL No. 4964

July 12, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Randall, Hertel, Giese, Bandstra, Fitzgerald, Gnodtke, Miller and Bender and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 617 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
being section 257.617 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 617 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of  
2 1949, being section 257.617 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 617. (1) The driver of a vehicle who knows or who has  
5 reason to believe that he OR SHE has been involved in an accident  
6 upon either public or private property, when the property is open  
7 to travel by the public, resulting in serious or aggravated  
8 injury to or death of a person shall immediately stop his OR HER  
9 vehicle at the scene of the accident and shall remain there until  
10 the requirements of section 619 are fulfilled. ~~Every~~ THE stop

1 shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is  
2 necessary.

3 (2) A person ~~failing to stop or to comply with those~~  
4 ~~requirements shall be~~ WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS guilty of a  
5 felony ~~—~~ punishable by imprisonment for not more than ~~—2—~~ 5  
6 years ~~—~~ or by A fine of not more than ~~—\$2,000.00—~~ \$5,000.00, or  
7 both.

8 (3) The secretary of state shall suspend the operator's or  
9 chauffeur's license of the person convicted UNDER THIS SECTION  
10 as provided in section 319.
