- 9 vehicle at the scene of the accident and shall remain there until
- 10 the requirements of section 619 are fulfilled. -Every THE stop

- 1 shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is
 2 necessary.
- 3 (2) A person failing to stop or to comply with those
- 4 requirements shall be WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS guilty of a
- 5 felcry $\overline{}$ punishable by imprisonment for not more than $\frac{2}{}$ 5
- 6 years --- or by A fine of not more than \$2,000.00 \$5,000.00, or
