

# HOUSE BILL No. 4968

July 12, 1989, Introduced by Rep. Bryant and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 11 of Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended

"The school aid act of 1979,"

as amended by Act No. 318 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 388.1611 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add article 13.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 11 of Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of  
2 1979, as amended by Act No. 318 of the Public Acts of 1988, being  
3 section 388.1611 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and  
4 article 13 is added to read as follows:

5       Sec. 11. (1) There is appropriated from the school aid fund  
6 established by section 11 of article IX of the state constitution  
7 of 1963, for the fiscal year ending September 30, ~~1989~~ 1990,  
8 the sum necessary to fulfill the requirements of this act, and

1 any deficiency is appropriated from the general fund by the  
 2 legislature. The appropriation shall be allocated as provided in  
 3 this act. The estimated appropriations and the estimated sources  
 4 of revenue provided for in this ~~1988~~ 1989 amendatory act are as  
 5 follows:

15 (2) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SUBSECTION (1), THERE IS  
 16 ESTABLISHED A SEPARATE ACCOUNT TO BE KNOWN AS THE SESQUICENTEN-  
 17 NIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT.  
 18 THIS ACCOUNT SHALL BE FUNDED BY REVENUES COLLECTED UNDER SECTION  
 19 7A OF ACT NO. 265 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1947, BEING SECTION  
 20 205.507A OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. FUNDS FROM THIS ACCOUNT  
 21 SHALL BE EXPENDED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES DESCRIBED IN ARTICLE 13.

### 23 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS

24 SEC. 131. FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1) AND  
 25 CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
 26 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),

1 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00 FOR  
2 1989-90 TO DISTRICTS FOR ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING IN EACH  
3 SCHOOL BUILDING A SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS AS DESCRIBED IN  
4 SECTION 1112 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976.

5 SEC. 132. FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1) AND  
6 CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS COM-  
7 MITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2), THERE  
8 IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000,000.00 FOR 1989-90 TO  
9 INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS TO ENABLE THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DIS-  
10 TRICTS TO FULFILL THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT FUNCTIONS REQUIRED BY  
11 SECTION 1113 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976.

12 SEC. 133. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1)  
13 AND CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
14 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),  
15 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000,000.00 FOR  
16 1989-90 TO APPLICANT INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT  
17 OF NOT LESS THAN 3 EXPERIMENTAL SCHOOLS AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION  
18 1115 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976.

19 (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION,  
20 THE APPLICANT INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPART-  
21 MENT A PROPOSAL FOR ESTABLISHING AN EXPERIMENTAL SCHOOL. THE  
22 PROPOSAL SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS  
23 OF SECTION 1115 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976 AND OTHER CRITERIA  
24 ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

25 SEC. 134. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1)  
26 AND CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
27 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),

1 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00 FOR  
2 1989-90 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS AND INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS FOR  
3 GRANTS OF \$1,000.00 TO 100 K TO 12 TEACHERS FOR THE DISSEMINATION  
4 OF CONCEPTS OF EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE.

5 (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION,  
6 THE APPLICANT DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO  
7 THE DEPARTMENT A PROPOSAL FOR DETERMINING, IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
8 CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH TEACHERS WOULD BE  
9 AWARDED A \$1,000.00 GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION.

10 SEC. 135. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1)  
11 AND CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
12 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),  
13 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000.00 FOR  
14 1989-90 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS AND INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS FOR THE  
15 OPERATION OF A MENTOR TEACHER PROGRAM AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION  
16 1118 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976. EACH MENTOR TEACHER PARTICIPAT-  
17 ING IN THE PROGRAM, NOT TO EXCEED 200 TEACHERS IN 1989-90, IN  
18 ADDITION TO ALL OTHER REMUNERATION AND BENEFITS TO WHICH THE  
19 TEACHER IS OTHERWISE ENTITLED, SHALL RECEIVE A GRANT OF \$1,000.00  
20 PER YEAR.

21 (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION,  
22 THE APPLICANT DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO

24 TEACHER PROGRAM. THE PROPOSAL SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN ACCORDANCE  
25 WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 1118 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976  
26 AND OTHER CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

1        SEC. 136. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1)  
2 AND CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
3 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),  
4 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00 FOR  
5 1989-90 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS AND INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS FOR A  
6 SABBATICAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1119 OF THE  
7 SCHOOL CODE OF 1976. EACH TEACHER PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM  
8 SHALL RECEIVE, IN ADDITION TO HIS OR HER REGULAR SALARY, 5% OF  
9 THE AMOUNT OF HIS OR HER SALARY, NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00.

10        (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION,  
11 THE APPLICANT DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO  
12 THE DEPARTMENT A PROPOSAL FOR DEVELOPING AND OPERATING A SABBATI-  
13 CAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM. THE PROPOSAL SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN ACCORD-  
14 ANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 1119 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF  
15 1976 AND OTHER CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

16        SEC. 137. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1)  
17 AND CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
18 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),  
19 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00 FOR  
20 1989-90 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND IMPLI-  
21 MENTATION OF A VOLUNTARY INTEGRATION EXCHANGE PROGRAM AS  
22 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1120 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976. A GRANT  
23 AWARDED TO EACH COMBINATION OF DISTRICTS PARTICIPATING IN AN  
24 INTEGRATION EXCHANGE PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOT EXCEED  
25 \$10,000.00.

26        (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION,  
27 THE APPLICANT DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO

1 THE DEPARTMENT A PROPOSAL FOR DEVELOPING AND OPERATING AN  
2 INTEGRATION EXCHANGE PROGRAM. THE PROPOSAL SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN  
3 ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 1120 OF THE SCHOOL  
4 CODE OF 1976 AND OTHER CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

5 SEC. 138. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1)  
6 AND CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
7 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),  
8 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000.00 FOR  
9 1989-90 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS AND INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS FOR THE  
10 DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATION OF A SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM AS DESCRIBED  
11 IN SECTION 1121 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976.

12 (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION,  
13 THE APPLICANT DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO  
14 THE DEPARTMENT A PROPOSAL FOR DEVELOPING AND OPERATING A SUMMER  
15 CAMP PROGRAM. THE PROPOSAL SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN ACCORDANCE WITH  
16 THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 1121 OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976 AND  
17 OTHER CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

18 SEC. 139. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11(1)  
19 AND CREDITED TO THE SESQUICENTENNIAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS  
20 COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11(2),  
21 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000,000.00 FOR  
22 1989-90 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS AND INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS FOR THE  
23 DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATION OF SCHOOL DROPOUT PREVENTION AND  
24 RETRIEVAL PROGRAMS AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1122 OF THE SCHOOL  
25 CODE OF 1976.

26 (2) IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION,  
27 THE APPLICANT DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO

1 THE DEPARTMENT A PROPOSAL FOR DEVELOPING AND OPERATING A SCHOOL  
2 DROPOUT PREVENTION AND RETRIEVAL PROGRAM. THE PROPOSAL SHALL BE  
3 DEVELOPED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 1122 OF  
4 THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976 AND OTHER CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE  
5 DEPARTMENT.

6 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
7 all of the following bills of the 85th Legislature are enacted  
8 into law:
