A bill to amend the title and section 7 of Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 1975, entitled

"An act to provide for the registration and regulation of off-road recreation vehicles; and to provide penalties,"

being section 257.1607 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 6a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and section 7 of Act No. 319 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1975, being section 257.1607 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, are amended and section 6a is added to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 TITLE
- 6 An act to provide for the registration and regulation of
- 7 off-road recreation vehicles; TO CREATE CERTAIN FUNDS; and to
- 8 provide penalties.

- 1 SEC. 6A. (1) THE RECREATIONAL ORV TRAIL IMPROVEMENT FUND IS
- 2 CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY. THE FUND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY
- 3 THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND SHALL BE USED SOLELY FOR
- 4 THE IMPROVEMENT, MAINTENANCE, AND CONSTRUCTION OF ORV TRAILS.
- 5 (2) AFTER DEDUCTING THE AMOUNTS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION

- 13 (4) ALL FUNDS ALLOCATED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE FOR PROJECTS

- 15 (5) ANY MONEY REMAINING IN THE RECREATIONAL ORV TRAIL
- 16 IMPROVEMENT FUND AT THE END OF A FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE CARRIED
- 17 OVER IN THE FUND TO THE NEXT AND SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEARS AND

- 4 and their effects and impact on this state and its environment;
- 5 and acquiring equipment necessary to implement this act. The

- 7 include in their annual budget requests information detailing
- 8 these programs. The budget requests shall not exceed anticipated
- 9 revenues.
