

HOUSE BILL No. 5003

July 27, 1989, Introduced by Rep. Willis Bullard and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 227 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
as amended by Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 750.227 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 227 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of
2 1931, as amended by Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of 1986, being
3 section 750.227 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 227. (1) A person shall not carry a dagger, dirk, sti-
6 letto, a double-edged nonfolding stabbing instrument of any
7 length, or any other dangerous weapon, except a hunting knife
8 adapted and carried as such, concealed on or about his or her
9 person, or whether concealed or otherwise in any vehicle operated

1 or occupied by the person, except in his or her dwelling house,
2 place of business or on other land possessed by the person.

3 (2) A person shall not carry ~~a~~ AN OPERABLE OR INOPERABLE
4 pistol concealed on or about his or her person, or, whether con-
5 cealed or otherwise, in a vehicle operated or occupied by the
6 person, except in his or her dwelling house, place of business,
7 or on other land possessed by the person, without a license to
8 carry the pistol as provided by law and if licensed, shall not
9 carry the pistol in a place or manner inconsistent with any
10 restrictions ~~upon such~~ OF THAT license.

11 (3) A person who violates this section is guilty of a
12 felony, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years, or
13 by a fine of not more than \$2,500.00, OR BOTH.
