

HOUSE BILL No. 5059

September 21, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Dunaskiss, Middaugh, Clack, Rocca, Hoekman, Miller, Profit, Sofio, Joe Young, Jr., Varga, Bartnik, O'Connor, Jaye, Camp, Law, Weeks, Runco, Willis Bullard, Trim, Allen, Wartner, Pridnia, DeMars, Strand, Krause, Gilmer and London and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to prohibit executive agencies or employees from using fictitious employee names under certain circumstances.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "agency" means that term as
2 defined in section 3 of the administrative procedures act of
3 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, being section
4 24.203 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

5 Sec. 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), an agency
6 or an employee of an agency shall not, in conducting state busi-
7 ness, use a fictitious employee name, assign a name to an
8 employee who does not exist, nor in any other way mislead a
9 member of the public about the identity or existence of an
10 employee of the agency or any other agency.

11 (2) This act does not apply to the department of state
12 police in conducting a criminal investigation.
