

HOUSE BILL No. 5123

October 2, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Bandstra, Hollister, Gire, Profit, Fitzgerald, Strand, Munsell, Johnson, Gilmer, Sikkema, London, Perry Bullard, Krause, DeLange, Berman, Stabenow, Miller, Jondahl, DeBeaussaert, Kosteva, Pitoniak and Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on Liquor Control.

A bill to amend Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended

"The Michigan liquor control act,"

as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding sections 21a and 21b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra
2 Session of 1933, as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding sections 21a and
4 21b to read as follows:

5 SEC. 21A. A RETAIL LICENSEE SHALL NOT SPONSOR, PROMOTE,
6 CONDUCT, OR ALLOW TO BE CONDUCTED IN A LICENSED PREMISES, ON THE
7 BUSINESS PREMISES OF THE LICENSEE CONTAINING THE LICENSED
8 PREMISES, OR IN AN AREA ADJACENT TO THAT BUSINESS PREMISES, A
9 CONTEST, EXHIBITION, OR OTHER ACTIVITY THAT HAS AS AN OBJECTIVE

1 THE THROWING, TOSSING, OR OTHERWISE PROPELLING OF AN INDIVIDUAL
2 OF PROPORTIONATE OR DISPROPORTIONATE SHORT STATURE BY ANOTHER
3 INDIVIDUAL. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SHORT STATURE" MEANS A
4 HEIGHT OF NOT MORE THAN 4 FEET, 10 INCHES.

5 SEC. 21B. A RETAIL LICENSEE SHALL NOT SPONSOR, PROMOTE,
6 CONDUCT, OR ALLOW TO BE CONDUCTED IN A LICENSED PREMISES, ON THE
7 BUSINESS PREMISES OF THE LICENSEE CONTAINING THE LICENSED
8 PREMISES, OR IN AN AREA ADJACENT TO THAT BUSINESS PREMISES, A
9 CONTEST, EXHIBITION, OR OTHER ACTIVITY THAT HAS AS AN OBJECTIVE
10 THE EXPLOITATION FOR ENTERTAINMENT OR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES OF AN
11 INDIVIDUAL BECAUSE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S PHYSICAL DEFORMITY OR
12 PHYSICAL OR MENTAL DISABILITY OR HANDICAP.
