

HOUSE BILL No. 5136

October 4, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Crandall, Hickner, Pridnia, Hertel, Bandstra, Bennane, Krause, O'Connor, Johnson, Saunders, Bender, Gubow, Hunter, Fitzgerald, Law, Stabenow, Camp, Gire, Berman, Knight, DeMars and Munsell and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend section 16181 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended

"Public health code,"

as amended by Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 333.16181 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 16181 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts
2 of 1978, as amended by Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of 1986,
3 being section 333.16181 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
4 to read as follows:

5 Sec. 16181. A board may ~~grant~~ ISSUE a nonrenewable, tem-
6 porary license to an applicant who has completed all requirements
7 for licensure except for examination or other required evaluation
8 procedure. ~~A person~~ A BOARD SHALL NOT ISSUE A TEMPORARY
9 LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS PREVIOUSLY FAILED THE

1 EXAMINATION OR whose license has been suspended or revoked.
2 ~~shall not be issued a temporary license.~~ A temporary license
3 issued pursuant to this section is valid for 1 year, ~~until the~~
4 ~~results of the next scheduled examination are available or the~~
5 ~~results of the next required evaluation procedure are available~~
6 ~~and a reasonable time elapses for issuance of the certificate of~~
7 ~~licensure, or until the examination date, if the applicant does~~
8 ~~not take the examination, whichever is sooner.~~ EXCEPT THAT A
9 BOARD SHALL AUTOMATICALLY REVOKE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE OF AN
10 APPLICANT WHO FAILS THE EXAMINATION OR OTHER REQUIRED EVALUATION
11 PROCEDURE. The department shall promptly issue a temporary
12 license.
