

HOUSE BILL No. 5179

October 16, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Joe Young, Jr. and DeMars
and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 8 of Act No. 333 of the Public Acts
of 1976, entitled

"An act to provide for the licensing of elevator journeymen and
the regulation of elevators and elevator journeymen; to prescribe
the functions of the director of labor and the elevator safety
board; and to provide penalties for violations of this act,"

being section 338.2158 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 8 of Act No. 333 of the Public Acts of
2 1976, being section 338.2158 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 8. (1) Fees for the elevator journeyman's license and
5 elevator journeyman's examination shall be determined by the
6 board.

7 (2) Fees shall be paid by cash, money order, or certified
8 check to the director. Fees received by the director shall be

1 transmitted to the state treasurer for deposit in the ~~general~~
2 ~~fund~~ STATE ELEVATOR INSPECTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 16A OF
3 ACT NO. 227 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1967, BEING SECTION 408.816A OF
4 THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

5 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
6 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 5180 (request
7 no. 02819'89) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
