A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 167 of the Public Acts of 1917, entitled as amended

"Housing law of Michigan,"

being section 125.401 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 167 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1917, being section 125.401 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1. (1) This act shall be known AND MAY BE CITED as the
- 5 "housing law of Michigan". and all provisions thereof shall
- 6 apply to every
- 7 (2) THIS ACT APPLIES TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) A city -and OR organized village in -the-THIS state
- 9 -which, by the last regular or special federal census, had THAT
- 10 HAS a population of 100,000 or more. , and to every city or

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- 1 village as its population shall reach 100,000 thereafter and also
- 2 to that territory
- 3 (B) TERRITORY immediately adjacent and contiguous to the
- 4 boundaries of -such- a city or village DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION
- 5 (A) and extending for a radial distance of 2-1/2 miles beyond
- 6 their ITS boundaries in all directions. This act shall also
- 7 apply to any city and organized village in this state which, as
- 8 determined by the last regular or special federal census; has or
- 9 shall hereafter attain
- 10 (C) IN THE CASE OF ALL DWELLINGS EXCEPT PRIVATE DWELLINGS
- 11 AND 2-FAMILY DWELLINGS AS DEFINED IN THIS ACT, A CITY OR VILLAGE
- 12 THAT HAS a population of 10,000 or more. However, the provi-
- 13 sions of this act relating to private dwellings and 2 family
- 14 dwellings as hereinafter defined shall not apply to any city or
- 15 organized village lying outside the 2 1/2 mile radius and having
- 16 a population of less than 100,000 unless
- 17 (D) IN THE CASE OF ALL DWELLINGS THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE
- 18 RENTAL HOUSING QUALITY ENFORCEMENT ACT, ALL CITIES, VILLAGES, AND
- 19 TOWNSHIPS IN THIS STATE.
- 20 (3) IF A CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP IS NOT SUBJECT TO THIS
- 21 ACT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2), the legislative body of the city,
- 22 -or village, OR TOWNSHIP MAY ADOPT THE ACT by resolution -,
- 23 passed by a majority vote of the members elect of the legislative
- 24 body. , adopt the provisions. In the case of charter townships
- 25 and townships the provisions of this act relating to private
- 26 dwellings and 2 family dwellings may be applied to those areas by

- 1 ordinance of the respective township board adopting the
- 2 provisions.
- 3 (4) This act -shall-apply- APPLIES to all dwellings within
- 4 the classes defined in -the following sections SECTION 2, except
- 5 that in sections OF THIS ACT where specific reference is made to
- 6 1 or more specific classes of dwellings, those provisions -shall-
- 7 apply only to those classes to which specific reference is made.
- 8 All other provisions which relate to dwellings -shall apply to
- 9 all classes of dwellings.
- 10 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 11 Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5187 (request
- 12 no. 03372'89) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
