

# HOUSE BILL No. 5184

October 16, 1989, Introduced by Reps. A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931,  
entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 193a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as  
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 193a to read as follows:

4       SEC. 193A. A PROBATIONER WHO IS INCARCERATED IN A SPECIAL  
5 ALTERNATIVE INCARCERATION UNIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 3B OF CHAPTER  
6 XI OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, ACT NO. 175 OF THE PUBLIC  
7 ACTS OF 1927, BEING SECTION 771.3B OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS,  
8 AND WHO ESCAPES FROM THE UNIT OR WHO LEAVES THE UNIT WITHOUT  
9 BEING RELEASED OR DISCHARGED FROM THE UNIT BY DUE PROCESS OF LAW,

1 IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE  
2 THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH. A  
3 TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION  
4 SHALL BEGIN TO RUN AT THE EXPIRATION OF ANY TERM OF IMPRISONMENT  
5 IMPOSED FOR THE OFFENSE FOR WHICH THE PERSON WAS INCARCERATED AT  
6 THE UNIT AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION.

7 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
8 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5185 (request  
9 no. 03130'89a) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
