## **HOUSE BILL No. 5206**

October 18, 1989, Introduced by Rep. Bennett and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to prohibit the use of certain hormones in certain milk products sold, offered for sale, or distributed in this state; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "BST" means bovine somatotropin.
- 3 (b) "Milk product" means cream, light cream, coffee cream,
- 4 table cream, whipping cream, light whipping cream, heavy cream,
- 5 heavy whipping cream, whipped cream, whipped light cream, whipped
- 6 coffee cream, whipped table cream, sour cream, cultured sour
- 7 cream, half-and-half, sour half-and-half, cultured half-and-half,
- 8 reconstituted or recombined milk and milk products, concentrated
- 9 milk, concentrated milk products, skim milk, skimmed milk, lowfat

- 1 milk, fortified milk and milk products, vitamin D milk and milk
- 2 products, homogenized milk, flavored milk or milk products, but-
- 3 termilk, cultured buttermilk, cultured milk, cultured whole milk
- 4 buttermilk, acidified milk and milk products, cheese, cottage
- 5 cheese, creamed cottage cheese, butter, dry milk, dry skimmed
- 6 milk, eggnog, and any other final milk product.
- 7 (c) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,

- 12 Sec. 3. (1) A person who violates this act is responsible
- 13 to the state for a civil fine of not less than \$5,000.00 per

- 15 (2) Milk products sold, offered for sale, or otherwise dis-
- 16 tributed in this state in violation of this act are subject to
- 17 confiscation and destruction by the department of agriculture.
- 18 (3) A default in the payment of a civil fine or costs
- 19 ordered under this act or an installment of the fine or costs may
- 20 be remedied by any means authorized under the revised judicature
