- 8 to use his OR HER credited service in force previously acquired
- 9 as a member of governmental unit retirement systems in meeting
- 10 the service requirements of the system from which he OR SHE

- 1 retires. If -he THE MEMBER has a break in governmental unit
- 2 employment for a period longer than -5 15 years, his OR HER
- 3 service rendered in the employ of the governmental units prior to
- 4 his OR HER last break in service shall not be used in satisfying
- 5 the service requirement for age and service retirement in the
- 6 system from which he OR SHE retires. Credited service acquired
- 7 in a governmental unit in which -he THE MEMBER was previously
- 8 employed shall not be used in determining the amount of his OR
- 9 HER retirement allowance payable by the reciprocal retirement
