

HOUSE BILL No. 5319

December 4, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Perry Bullard, Gubow and Jondahl and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended

"The insurance code of 1956,"

as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding sections 3402a and 3652.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding sections 3402a and 3652 to
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 3402A. AN INSURER AUTHORIZED TO WRITE DISABILITY
6 INSURANCE IN THIS STATE SHALL NOT DELIVER OR ISSUE FOR DELIVERY A
7 POLICY OF DISABILITY INSURANCE THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR ONLY
8 SPECIFIED DISEASES.

1 SEC. 3652. AN INSURER AUTHORIZED TO WRITE DISABILITY
2 INSURANCE IN THIS STATE SHALL NOT DELIVER OR ISSUE FOR DELIVERY A
3 POLICY OF GROUP DISABILITY, FAMILY EXPENSE, OR BLANKET DISABILITY
4 INSURANCE THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR ONLY SPECIFIED DISEASES.
