A bill to amend the title and section 2 of Act No. 372 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act."

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and section 2 of Act No. 372 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1927, section 2 as amended by Act No. 161 of the
- 3 Public Acts of 1986, being section 28.422 of the Michigan
- 4 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

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1 TITLE

2 An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, pos-

- 3 sessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting

- 9 Sec. 2. (1) A EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A
- 10 person shall not purchase, carry, or transport a pistol FIREARM
- 11 without first having obtained a license therefor as prescribed
- 12 in UNDER this section. . . except that any person who brings a
- 13 pistol into this state and
- 14 (2) A PERSON who is -either on leave from active duty with
- 15 the armed forces of the United States or who has been discharged
- 16 from -such active duty WITH THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED
- 17 STATES WHO BRINGS A FIREARM INTO THIS STATE shall obtain a
- 18 license for the pistol FIREARM within 5 days after his or her
- 19 arrival HE OR SHE ARRIVES in this state.
- 20 (3) The commissioner or chief of police of a city, township,
- 21 or village -, having an organized police department, or the duly
- 22 authorized deputy of the commissioner or chief of police; and the
- 23 sheriff, or a duly authorized deputy of the sheriff, in the parts
- 24 of a county not included within -such cities, townships, or
- 25 villages, A CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE having an organized
- 26 police department, may issue licenses to purchase, carry, or
- 27 transport -pistols- FIREARMS to applicants residing within the

- 1 city, village, township, or county, as applicable. A license
- 2 shall not be granted under this section to any person unless the
- 3 applicant meets all of the following CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST:
- 4 (a) —Is— THE APPLICANT IS 18 years of age or over.
- 5 (b) —Is— THE APPLICANT IS a citizen of the United States and
- 6 has resided in this state FOR 6 months or -more- LONGER.
- 7 (c) Has not been convicted of a felony or has not been
- 8 incarcerated as a result of a felony conviction in this state or
- 9 elsewhere during the 8 year period immediately preceding the date
- 10 of application.
- 11 (C) (d) Has THE APPLICANT HAS not been adjudged insane in
- 12 this state or elsewhere -unless OR he or she has been ADJUDGED
- 13 restored to sanity by court order.
- 14 (D) THE LICENSING AUTHORITY HAS CONDUCTED A CRIMINAL HISTORY
- 15 INVESTIGATION OF THE APPLICANT THROUGH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT INFOR-
- 16 MATION NETWORK AND DETERMINED THAT THE APPLICANT HAS NOT BEEN
- 17 CONVICTED OF A FELONY IN THIS STATE OR ELSEWHERE DURING THE
- 18 8-YEAR PERIOD IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF APPLICATION, AND
- 19 HAS NOT BEEN INCARCERATED DURING THE 8-YEAR PERIOD IMMEDIATELY
- 20 PRECEDING THE DATE OF APPLICATION FOR A FELONY CONVICTION IN THIS
- 21 STATE OR ELSEWHERE.
- 22 (E) THE LICENSING AUTHORITY HAS COLLECTED A \$2.00 FEE FROM
- 23 THE APPLICANT.
- 24 (4) EACH LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL COLLECT AN APPLICATION
- 25 FEE UNDER SUBSECTION (3)(E) AND SHALL FORWARD THAT FEE TO THE
- 26 DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY IN THE TIME AND IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED
- 27 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY. THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL

- 1 IMMEDIATELY DEPOSIT ALL FEES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION
- 2 IN THE GENERAL FUND.
- 3 (5) -(2) Applications for licenses under this section shall
- 4 be signed by the applicant under oath upon forms provided by the
- 5 director. Licenses to purchase, carry, or transport -pistols-
- 6 FIREARMS shall be executed in triplicate upon forms provided by
- 7 the director and shall be signed by the licensing authority.
- 8 Three copies of -such THE license shall be delivered to the
- 9 applicant by the licensing authority.
- 10 (6) -(3) Upon the sale of -the pistol A FIREARM, the
- 11 seller shall fill out the license forms describing the -pistol-
- 12 FIREARM sold, together with the date of sale, and sign his or her
- 13 name in ink indicating that -such pistol THE FIREARM was sold to
- 14 the licensee. The licensee shall also sign his or her name in
- 15 ink indicating the purchase of such pistol THE FIREARM from the
- 16 seller. The seller may retain a copy of the license as a record
- 17 of the sale of the -pistol- FIREARM. The licensee shall return
- 18 2 copies of the license to the licensing authority within 10 days
- 19 -following the purchase of AFTER HE OR SHE PURCHASES the
- 20 -pistol FIREARM.
- 21 (7) -(4) One copy of the license shall be retained by the
- 22 licensing authority as -a permanent AN official record for a
- 23 period of 6 years. -and the THE other copy OF THE LICENSE shall
- 24 be forwarded TO THE DIRECTOR by the licensing authority within
- 25 48 hours -to the director- AFTER THE LICENSE IS RECEIVED BY THE
- 26 LICENSING AUTHORITY. A license -shall-be- IS void unless THE

- 1 LICENSE IS used within 10 days after the -date of its issue-
- 2 LICENSE IS ISSUED.
- 3 (8) -(5). This section does not apply to the purchase of
- 4 -pistols- FIREARMS from wholesalers by dealers regularly engaged
- 5 in the business of selling pistols FIREARMS at retail, nor OR
- 6 to the sale, barter, or exchange of pistols FIREARMS kept
- 7 solely as relics, curios, or antiques, IF THOSE FIREARMS ARE not
- 8 made for modern ammunition or ARE permanently deactivated. This
- 9 section does not prevent the transfer of ownership of pistols
- 10 FIREARMS which are inherited if the license to purchase is
- 11 approved by the commissioner or chief of police, sheriff, or
- 12 -their AN authorized -deputies DEPUTY OF THE COMMISSIONER OR
- 13 CHIEF OF POLICE OR SHERIFF, and signed by the personal represen-
- 14 tative of the estate or by the next of kin having authority to
- 15 dispose of the -pistol FIREARM.
- 16 (9) $\frac{-(6)}{}$ As used in this section, "director" means the
- 17 director of the department of state police.
- 18 (10) -(7) A person who forges any matter on an application
- 19 for a license under this section is guilty of a felony.
- 20 (11) A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY MAKES A FALSE STATEMENT REGARD-
- 21 ING A MATERIAL FACT ON AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS
- 22 SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY.
