

HOUSE BILL No. 5359

December 12, 1989, Introduced by Reps. Kosteva, Bartnik, Berman, Profit, Gubow, DeMars, Weeks, Wallace, Stallworth, Porreca, Richard A. Young, Emerson, Jonker, Pitoniak, Leland, Jondahl, Hood, O'Neill, Bennane, Perry Bullard, Hart, Barns, Owen, Kilpatrick, Palamara, Saunders, Harrison, Brown and Gire and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Fisheries and Wildlife.

A bill to amend section 231 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
as amended by Act No. 103 of the Public Acts of 1981, being section 750.231 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 231 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of
2 1931, as amended by Act No. 103 of the Public Acts of 1981, being
3 section 750.231 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 231. Sections 224, 227, 227c, and 227d do not apply
6 to any OF THE FOLLOWING:

7 (A) A peace officer of a duly authorized police agency of
8 the United States, of this state, or of ~~any~~ A political
9 subdivision of this state, who is regularly employed and paid by

1 the United States, this state, or a political subdivision of this
2 state. ~~, or to any~~ HOWEVER, THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT PERMIT A
3 PEACE OFFICER TO MANUFACTURE, SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR POSSESS A
4 MACHINE GUN OR FIREARM WHICH SHOOTS OR IS DESIGNED TO SHOOT AUTO-
5 Matically MORE THAN 1 SHOT WITHOUT MANUAL RELOADING, BY A SINGLE
6 FUNCTION OF THE TRIGGER, EXCEPT IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

7 (B) A person regularly employed by the state department of
8 corrections, ~~and~~ WHO IS authorized in writing by the director
9 of the department of corrections to carry a concealed weapon
10 while ~~in the official performance of~~ PERFORMING his or her
11 OFFICIAL duties or while going to or returning from those
12 duties. ~~, or to any~~ HOWEVER, THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT PERMIT
13 A PERSON REGULARLY EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO
14 MANUFACTURE, SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR POSSESS A MACHINE GUN OR
15 FIREARM WHICH SHOOTS OR IS DESIGNED TO SHOOT AUTOMATICALLY MORE
16 THAN 1 SHOT WITHOUT MANUAL RELOADING, BY A SINGLE FUNCTION OF THE
17 TRIGGER, EXCEPT IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

18 (C) A member of the army, air force, navy, or marine corps
19 of the United States when carrying weapons in THE line of DUTY or
20 incidental to THE LINE OF duty. ~~, or to organizations~~

21 (D) AN ORGANIZATION authorized by law to purchase or receive
22 weapons from the United States or from this state. ~~, or to~~
23 ~~members~~

24 (E) A MEMBER of the national guard, armed forces reserves,
25 or other duly authorized military ~~organizations~~ ORGANIZATION
26 when on duty or drill, or ~~in~~ WHEN going to or returning from
27 ~~their places~~ HIS OR HER PLACE of assembly or practice by a

1 direct route or otherwise, while carrying ~~weapons~~ A WEAPON used
2 for purposes of the national guard, armed forces reserves, or
3 other duly authorized military ~~organizations~~ ORGANIZATION.
