THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 16401 and 16423 of Act No. 368 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.16401 and 333.16423 of
- 3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 16401. (1) As used in this part:
- 5 (a) "Chiropractor", "chiropractic physician", "doctor of
- 6 chiropractic", or "d.c." means an individual licensed under this
- 7 article to engage in the practice of chiropractic.
- 8 (b) "Practice of chiropractic" means that discipline within
- 9 the healing arts which deals with the nervous system and its

- 2 other body systems. THE PRACTICE OF CHIROPRACTIC DOES NOT
- 3 INCLUDE THE PERFORMANCE OF INCISIVE SURGICAL PROCEDURES, THE PER-
- 4 FORMANCE OF AN INVASIVE PROCEDURE REQUIRING INSTRUMENTATION, OR
- 5 THE DISPENSING OR PRESCRIBING OF DRUGS OR MEDICINE. Practice of

- 15 (iii) -(ii) The adjustment of spinal subluxations or mis-
- 16 alignments and related bones and tissues INCLUDING THE PELVIC
- 17 BONES for the establishment of neural integrity utilizing the
- 18 inherent recuperative powers of the body for restoration and
- 19 maintenance of health.
- 20 (iv) -(iii) The use of analytical instruments, nutritional
- 21 advice, rehabilitative exercise, and adjustment apparatus regu-
- 22 lated by rules promulgated by the board pursuant to section
- 23 16423, and the use of x-ray machines in the examination of
- 24 patients for the purpose of locating spinal subluxations or misa-

- 7 Sec. 16423. (1) The board shall promulgate rules to estab-
- 8 lish criteria for the approval of analytical instruments and
- 9 adjustment apparatus to be used for the purpose of examining
- 10 patients in locating 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- (A) EXAMINING PATIENTS TO LOCATE AND ASSIST IN THE CORREC-
- 12 TION OF spinal subluxations and misalignments of the human spine
- 13 AND PELVIC BONES.
- 14 (B) EXAMINING PATIENTS TO LOCATE SPINAL SUBLUXATIONS AND
- 15 MISALIGNMENTS OF THE HUMAN SPINE AND PELVIC BONES AND TO DETER-
- 16 MINE THE EFFECTS OF THOSE SUBLUXATIONS AND MISALIGNMENTS ON OTHER
- 17 BODY SYSTEMS.
- 18 (C) EXAMINING PATIENTS TO DETERMINE THE NECESSITY OF CHIRO-
- 19 PRACTIC CARE.
- 20 (2) The criteria established UNDER SUBSECTION (1) shall be
- 21 substantially equivalent to nationally recognized standards in
- 22 the profession for the use and operation of the ANALYTICAL
- 23 instruments AND ADJUSTMENT APPARATUS. The board may approve
- 24 types and makes of analytical instruments AND ADJUSTMENT
- 25 APPARATUS that meet these criteria.
- 26 (3) -(2) An individual shall not use analytical instruments
- 27 or adjustment apparatus -which THAT does not meet nationally
