A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended

"Public health code,"

as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding sections 21541 and 21542; and to repeal certain parts of the act on a specific date.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as

- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding sections 21541 and 21542 to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 SEC. 21541. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION
- 6 (2), A HOSPITAL THAT EMPLOYS POSTGRADUATE TRAINEES TO PROVIDE
- 7 DIRECT PATIENT CARE SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

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- 1 (A) THE HOSPITAL SHALL NOT SCHEDULE A POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE
- 2 TO WORK MORE THAN AN AVERAGE OF 80 HOURS PER WEEK OVER A
- 3 CONSECUTIVE 4-WEEK PERIOD.
- 4 (B) THE HOSPITAL SHALL NOT SCHEDULE A POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE
- 5 TO WORK MORE THAN 28 CONSECUTIVE HOURS.
- 6 (C) A HOSPITAL SHALL SEPARATE SCHEDULED ON-DUTY ASSIGNMENTS
- 7 FOR POSTGRADUATE TRAINEES BY NONWORKING PERIODS OF NOT LESS THAN
- 8 8 HOURS AND SHALL SCHEDULE EACH POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE TO NOT LESS
- 9 THAN 1 NONWORKING PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN 24 CONSECUTIVE HOURS
- 10 PER WEEK.
- 11 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO POSTGRADUATE TRAINEES
- 12 WHO WORK ON-CALL DUTY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6 P.M. AND 6 A.M. IF
- 13 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:
- (A) THE HOSPITAL CAN DOCUMENT TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE
- 15 DEPARTMENT THAT DURING ON-CALL DUTY AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSEC-
- 16 TION, POSTGRADUATE TRAINEES ARE GENERALLY RESTING AND THAT CALLS
- 17 FOR PATIENT CARE ARE INFREOUENT AND LIMITED TO PATIENTS FOR WHOM
- 18 A POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE HAS CONTINUING RESPONSIBILITY.
- 19 (B) THE HOSPITAL DOES NOT SCHEDULE A POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE
- 20 FOR ON-CALL DUTY AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION MORE FREQUENTLY
- 21 THAN ONCE EVERY 3 DAYS.
- 22 (C) THE HOSPITAL SCHEDULES A NONWORKING PERIOD OF NOT LESS
- 23 THAN 16 HOURS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ON-CALL DUTY AS DESCRIBED IN
- 24 THIS SUBSECTION.
- 25 (D) THE HOSPITAL DEVELOPS AND IMPLEMENTS WRITTEN POLICIES
- 26 AND PROCEDURES TO IMMEDIATELY RELIEVE A POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE FROM
- 27 A CONTINUING ASSIGNMENT IF THE POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE IS OBSERVED

- 1 TO BE FATIGUED AFTER ON-CALL DUTY AS DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 2 SUBSECTION.
- 3 (3) SUBSECTION (1) APPLIES TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING HOSPITAL
- 4 SERVICES:
- 5 (A) ANESTHESIOLOGY.
- 6 (B) FAMILY PRACTICE.
- 7 (C) MEDICAL.
- 8 (D) SURGICAL.
- 9 (E) OBSTETRIC.
- 10 (F) PEDIATRIC.
- 11 (G) A SERVICE, OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED IN SUBDIVISIONS (A)
- 12 TO (F) AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, WITH A HIGH VOLUME OF ACUTELY ILL
- 13 PATIENTS.
- 14 (4) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO SERVICES, OTHER THAN
- 15 THOSE LISTED IN SUBSECTION (3) AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, IN WHICH
- 16 NIGHT CALLS ARE INFREOUENT AND THE RESIDENT PHYSICIANS GET ADE-
- 17 QUATE PERIODS OF REST INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PSYCHIATRIC
- 18 SERVICES. A HOSPITAL MAY MODIFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION
- 19 (1) FOR A SERVICE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION. A HOSPITAL THAT
- 20 MODIFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1) FOR A SERVICE

- 23 (5) A HOSPITAL THAT HAS AN EMERGENCY ROOM OR DEPARTMENT THAT

- 25 EMPLOYS POSTGRADUATE TRAINEES TO PROVIDE DIRECT PATIENT CARE
- 26 SHALL NOT SCHEDULE A POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE TO WORK IN THE

- 1 EMERGENCY ROOM OR DEPARTMENT MORE THAN 12 CONSECUTIVE HOURS PER
- 2 24-HOUR PERIOD.
- 3 (6) A HOSPITAL DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SHALL DEVELOP AND
- 4 IMPLEMENT A SPECIFIC, WRITTEN POLICY PERTAINING TO SCHEDULES AND
- 5 LIMITS OF ASSIGNED RESPONSIBILITY OF POSTGRADUATE TRAINEES
- 6 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ASSIGNMENT OF CARE FOR NEW
- 7 PATIENTS.
- 8 (7) EACH HOSPITAL THAT ADMITS RESIDENT PHYSICIANS TO PRAC-
- 9 TICE SHALL HAVE AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES INTRAVENOUS SERVICES,
- 10 PHLEBOTOMY SERVICES, AND MESSENGER AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES
- 11 SUFFICIENT TO MEET REASONABLE AND EXPECTED DEMANDS.
- 12 (8) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES TO IMPLEMENT THIS
- 13 SECTION.
- 14 SEC. 21542. (1) THE TASK FORCE ON HOSPITAL MANAGEMENT AND
- 15 POSTGRADUATE TRAINEE EDUCATION IS CREATED IN THE DEPARTMENT. THE
- 16 TASK FORCE SHALL CONSIST OF 15 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR
- 17 WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE AS FOLLOWS:
- 18 (A) EIGHT MEMBERS SHALL BE PHYSICIANS, 4 OF WHOM SHALL BE
- 19 POSTGRADUATE TRAINEES.
- 20 (B) FOUR MEMBERS SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVE OF HOSPITALS.
- 21 (C) THREE MEMBERS SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE INSURANCE.

- 23 (2) THE MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF
- 24 3 YEARS. A VACANCY ON THE TASK FORCE SHALL BE FILLED IN THE SAME
- 25 MANNER AS THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT FOR THE BALANCE OF THE UNEX-
- 26 PIRED TERM.

- (3) THE TASK FORCE SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (A) FILE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE OPERATION OF SECTION 21541
- 3 WITH THE SENATE AND HOUSE COMMITTEES WITH JURISDICTION OVER MAT-
- 4 TERS PERTAINING TO PUBLIC HEALTH.
- 5 (B) RECOMMEND TO THE DEPARTMENT CHANGES TO THE REQUIREMENTS
- 6 OF SECTION 21541, IF CHANGES ARE CONSIDERED NECESSARY BY THE TASK
- 7 FORCE.
- 8 (4) THE DEPARTMENT MAY MODIFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF
- 9 SECTION 21541 BY PROMULGATING RULES THAT EFFECTUATE THE RECOMMEN-
- 10 DATIONS OF THE TASK FORCE MADE UNDER SUBSECTION (3).
- 11 (5) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE UPON THE EXPIRATION
- 12 OF 4 YEARS AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE.
