- 6 DETERMINED ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE MEDICAL SERVICES UNDER SECTION 106
- 7 IS ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICAL SERVICES UNDER THIS ACT IF THE CHILD
- 8 RESIDES IN A HOUSEHOLD IN WHICH THE FAMILY INCOME OF THE
- 9 HOUSEHOLD DOES NOT EXCEED 100% OF THE OFFICIAL INCOME POVERTY
