

HOUSE BILL No. 5613

March 19, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Miller, Griffin, Randall, Murphy and Rocca and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend sections 4a, 7a, and 15 of Act No. 290 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled "Boiler act of 1965," section 4a as amended by Act No. 277 of the Public Acts of 1986 and section 7a as amended by Act No. 176 of the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 408.754a, 408.757a, and 408.765 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 4a, 7a, and 15 of Act No. 290 of the
2 Public Acts of 1965, section 4a as amended by Act No. 277 of the
3 Public Acts of 1986 and section 7a as amended by Act No. 176 of
4 the Public Acts of 1982, being sections 408.754a, 408.757a, and
5 408.765 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as
6 follows:

1 Sec. 4a. (1) ~~The board, with the advice of the director,~~
 2 ~~shall promulgate rules pursuant to The administrative procedures~~
 3 ~~act of 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended,~~
 4 ~~being sections 24.201 to 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, to~~
 5 ~~establish the fee schedules for licenses, permits, certificates,~~
 6 ~~and inspections.~~ The fees DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (2), (3), AND
 7 (4) shall reflect the actual costs and expenses for the depart-
 8 ment of labor in issuing licenses, permits, and certificates and
 9 in conducting inspections.

10 (2) FEES FOR LICENSES, PERMITS, CERTIFICATES, AND INSPEC-
 11 TIONS SHALL BE PAID ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

13 (3) THE BOILER DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR SHALL
 14 PROVIDE, UPON REQUEST, SPECIAL INSPECTIONS NOT OTHERWISE COVERED
 15 IN THE FEE SCHEDULE. THE CHARGE FOR THIS SERVICE SHALL BE AT THE
 16 RATE OF \$30.00 FOR THE FIRST HOUR AND \$30.00 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL
 17 HOUR, PLUS LODGING, MEALS, TRANSPORTATION, AND OTHER RELATED
 18 EXPENSES INCURRED FOR PERFORMING SPECIAL INSPECTIONS.

19 (4) THE FEE FOR REISSUANCE OF A LOST OR DESTROYED LICENSE
 20 SHALL BE \$5.00.

21 (5) FEES REQUIRED UNDER THESE RULES SHALL BE PAID BY CASH,
 22 MONEY ORDER, OR CHECK TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

23 (6) ~~-(2)-~~ To accomplish the objectives of this section and
 24 this act, a state boiler inspection fund is created IN THE
 25 DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY. The state treasurer shall be the custo-
 26 dian of the fund and may invest the surplus of the fund in
 27 investments as in the state treasurer's judgment are in the best

1 interest of the fund. Earnings from those investments shall be
2 credited to the fund. The state treasurer shall notify the
3 director and the Legislature of interest credited and the balance
4 of the fund as of September 30 of each year. The director shall
5 supervise and administer the fund. Fees received by the depart-
6 ment of labor and money collected under this act shall be depos-
7 ited in the state boiler inspection fund and shall be appropri-
8 ated by the Legislature for the operations of the boiler division
9 and indirect overhead expenses in the department of labor. Funds
10 that are unexpended at the end of each fiscal year shall be
11 returned to the state boiler inspection fund.

12 Sec. 7a. (1) Antique traction steam boilers shall comply
13 with the rules promulgated by the board and shall be inspected
14 once every 3 years ~~— An owner of an antique traction steam~~
15 ~~boiler~~ EXCEPT THAT ITS OWNER may request an inspection more
16 often than every 3 years. Antique traction steam boilers used
17 for commercial purposes shall be inspected annually. ~~— If the~~
18 ~~inspection is made by a deputy inspector, the fee shall be~~
19 ~~\$25.00. Fees established in this section shall not be subject to~~
20 ~~change by rule. A~~ THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR SHALL ISSUE A certifi-
21 cate of inspection ~~— shall be issued by the department of labor~~
22 upon compliance with the applicable rules.

23 (2) This act shall not apply to miniature steam or marine
24 engines used as a hobby.

25 Sec. 15. If a license is lost or destroyed, a new license
26 shall, upon application and payment of ~~— a~~ THE fee ~~— of \$5.00 —~~

1 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 4A, be issued BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR in
2 its place without another examination.
