A bill to amend section 1461 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
being section 600.146' of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1461 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1961, being section 600.1461 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1461. (1) The term AS USED IN THIS ACT, "newspaper"
- 5 as used in the revised judicature act of 1961 shall be construed
- 6 to refer only to MEANS a newspaper published in the English lan-
- 7 quage for the dissemination of local or transmitted news and
- 8 intelligence of a general character or for the dissemination of
- 9 legal news, -which THAT MEETS BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING
- 0 REQUIREMENTS:

- (a) has HAS a bona fide list of paying subscribers or has
- 2 been published -at-not less than weekly intervals in the same
- 3 community without interruption for at least 2 years.
- 4 (b) has HAS been established, published, and circulated
- 5 -at not less than weekly intervals without interruption for at
- 6 least 1 year in the county where the court is situated. A news-
- 7 paper shall not lose eligibility for interruption of continuous
- 8 publication because of acts of God, labor disputes, or military
- 9 service of the publisher for a period of not to exceed 2 years,

- 12 (c) annually averages at least 25% news and editorial con-
