A bill to amend the title of Act No. 307 of the Public Acts of 1982, entitled as amended

"The environmental response act,"

as amended, being sections 299.601 to 299.611 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 9e.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title of Act No. 307 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1982, as amended, being sections 299.601 to 299.611 of the
- 3 Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and section 9e is added to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 TITLE
- 6 An act TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, WELFARE, AND
- 7 THE ENVIRONMENT FROM ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAMINATION AT CERTAIN SITES
- 8 IN THIS STATE; to provide for the identification, risk
- 9 assessment, and priority evaluation of environmental

- 1 contamination at certain sites in this state; to provide for
- 2 response activity; to prescribe certain powers and duties of the
- 3 governor and certain state agencies and officials; TO CREATE AN
- 4 OFFICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION AND PRESCRIBE ITS
- 5 POWERS AND DUTIES; to provide for the promulgation of rules; to
- 6 create an environmental response fund, a Michigan unclaimed
- 7 bottle fund, -and- a long-term maintenance trust fund AND AN

- 12 SEC. 9E. (1) THE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP REVOLVING LOAN FUND

- 14 (2) THE LOAN FUND SHALL RECEIVE, AS REVENUE, MONEY AS PRO-
- 15 VIDED IN THIS ACT, MONEY AS PROVIDED BY LAW, AND ANY GIFTS OR
- 16 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE LOAN FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT
- 17 THE INVESTMENT OF THE LOAN FUND. INTEREST AND EARNINGS OF THE
- 18 LOAN FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE LOAN FUND. MONEY IN THE LOAN

- 21 (3) MONEY IN THE LOAN FUND SHALL BE USED FOR LOANS, PURSUANT
- 22 TO RULES OF THE DEPARTMENT, TO ASSIST SMALL BUSINESSES THAT ARE
- 23 THE OWNERS OF SITES OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAMINATION OR ARE RESPON-
- 24 SIBLE FOR RESPONSE ACTIVITIES AT SUCH SITES IN FINANCING THE
- 25 RESPONSE ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO AN APPROVED REMEDIAL ACTION

- 2 (A) "LOAN FUND" MEANS THE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP REVOLVING
- 3 LOAN FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (1).
- 4 (B) "SMALL BUSINESS" MEANS THAT TERM AS IT IS DEFINED IN
- 5 SECTION 7A OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, ACT
- 6 NO. 306 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1969, BEING SECTION 24.207A OF THE
- 7 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
- 8 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 9 Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. (request
- 10 no. 04197'89) of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
