## **HOUSE BILL No. 5858**

June 5, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Nye, Martin, Bandstra, Law, Sparks, Muxlow, Dolan, DeMars and Crandall and referred to the Committee on Taxation.

A bill to impose a specific tax on spirits; to provide for the collection of the tax; to prescribe certain powers and duties of the liquor control commission; to provide for the disposition of the tax; and to repeal this act on a specific date.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Licensee" means the holder of a license as defined in
- 3 section 2i of the Michigan liquor control act, Act No. 8 of the
- 4 Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, being section 436.2i of
- 5 the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 6 (b) "Spirits" means that term as defined in section 2 of Act
- 7 No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, being sec-
- 8 tion 436.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 9 Sec. 2. In addition to any other taxes imposed by law, the
- 10 liquor control commission shall levy and collect on all spirits

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- 1 sold in the state, at the time of sale, a specific tax equal to
- 2 1% of the retail selling price of the spirits.
- 3 Sec. 3. Upon collection, the entire proceeds of the tax
- 4 collected under section 2 shall be deposited in the state trea-
- 5 sury to the credit of the drunk driver detention and correction
- 6 center fund.
- 7 Sec. 4. A licensee who on January 1, 1991 has on hand any
- 8 spirits shall file a complete inventory of those spirits with the
- 9 liquor control commission not later than January 31, 1991 and, at
- 10 the same time, remit to the commission a specific tax equal to 2%
- 11 of the retail selling price of the spirits. Upon receipt, the
- 12 proceeds of the tax levied under this section shall be deposited
- 13 in the state treasury to the credit of the drunk driver detention
- 14 and correction center fund.
- 15 Sec. 5. This act is repealed effective December 31, 1996.
- 16 Sec. 6. This act shall take effect January 1, 1991.
- 17 Sec. 7. This act shall not take effect unless all of the
- 18 following bills of the 85th Legislature are enacted into law:
