

HOUSE BILL No. 5888

June 19, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Van Regenmorter, Gagliardi, Jacobetti, Emmons, Sofio and Middaugh and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 8511 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
as amended by Act No. 290 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 600.8511 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 8511 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts
2 of 1961, as amended by Act No. 290 of the Public Acts of 1984,
3 being section 600.8511 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
4 to read as follows:

5 Sec. 8511. A district court magistrate shall have the fol-
6 lowing jurisdiction and duties:

7 (a) To arraign and sentence upon pleas of guilty or nolo
8 contendere for violations of the following acts or parts of acts,
9 or a local ordinance substantially corresponding to these acts or

1 parts of acts, when authorized by the chief judge of the district
2 court and if the maximum permissible punishment does not exceed
3 90 days in jail or a fine, or both:

4 (i) Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
5 1949, as amended, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan
6 Compiled Laws, except for violations of sections 625 and 625b OF
7 ACT NO. 300 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1949, BEING SECTIONS 257.625
8 AND 257.625B OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. However, the magis-
9 trate may have the jurisdiction to arraign defendants and set
10 bond with regard to violations of sections 625 and 625b OF ACT
11 NO. 300 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1949.

4 (b) To issue warrants for the arrest of a person upon the
5 written authorization of the prosecuting or municipal attorney,
'6 except written authorization shall not be required for a vehicle
7 law or ordinance violation within the jurisdiction of the magis-
8 trate if a police officer issued a traffic citation pursuant to
9 section 728 of the Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of the
10 Public Acts of 1949, as amended, being section 257.728 of the
11 Michigan Compiled Laws, and the defendant failed to appear.

12 (c) To fix bail and accept bond in all cases.

13 (d) To issue search warrants, when authorized to do so by a
14 district court judge.
