

HOUSE BILL No. 5893

June 21, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Hoekman, Bartnik, DeMars, Stallworth, Hoffman, Willis Bullard and Krause and referred to the Committee on Public Utilities.

A bill to amend Act No. 32 of the Public Acts of 1986, entitled as amended

"Emergency telephone service enabling act,"

as amended, being sections 484.1101 to 484.1707 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 401a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 32 of the Public Acts of 1986, as
2 amended, being sections 484.1101 to 484.1707 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 401a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 401A. (1) IN ADDITION TO THE CHARGES BILLED PURSUANT
6 TO SECTION 401, THE SERVICE SUPPLIER MAY BILL AND COLLECT A USER
7 FEE FROM ALL SERVICE USERS WITHIN THE 9-1-1 SERVICE DISTRICT.

1 (2) THE USER FEE SHALL BE USED TO COVER THE COSTS OF
2 PROVIDING THE 9-1-1 SERVICE BY THE PSAP TO THE 9-1-1 SERVICE
3 DISTRICT.

4 (3) ALL AMOUNTS COLLECTED THROUGH THE USER FEE SHALL BE PAID
5 TO THE PSAP SERVICING THE 9-1-1 SERVICE DISTRICT.

6 (4) THE AMOUNT OF FEES COLLECTED FROM SERVICE USERS UNDER
7 THIS SECTION SHALL NOT EXCEED THE COSTS OF PROVIDING THE 9-1-1
8 SERVICE BY THE PSAP.

9 (5) THE FEE TO BE BILLED SHALL BE COMPUTED BY DIVIDING THE
10 COSTS TO BE RECOVERED UNDER THIS SECTION BY THE TOTAL NUMBER OF
11 SERVICE USERS WITHIN THE 9-1-1 SERVICE DISTRICT.
